Data Protection Notice

The European Education and Culture Executive Agency ("EACEA") is committed to preserving your privacy. All personal data are dealt with in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 2018/1725 on the protection of personal data by the Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies¹ ("the data protection regulation").

The following Data Protection Notice outlines the policies by which the EACEA collects, manages and uses the personal data of the concerned individuals within the context of the **Erasmus+:** International dimension - Focus on Sub-Saharan Africa, taking place on 01/12/2022. The event will be organised via Webex, and certain personal data may appear in the recording. The event will be recorded and the recording will be published on the internet.

1. Who is responsible for processing your personal data (data controller)?

The controller is the Education Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency, BE-1049 Brussels

2. Which personal data are processed?

Mandatory data for the event organisation: your contact details, i.e. title, first name, last name, position/function, name of organisation, email address, city and country.

Optional data: voice and images of participants as part of the video and audio recording of the event.

- For speakers: first name, surname, images and voice as the event will be audio and video recorded

Attention of participants is drawn to the possibility to:

- provide, to the extent possible, anonymised data to register to the event or to submit any question to the Agency via the Webex chat during the event or via e-mail after the event (corporate email address without name e.g. contact@companyname.com).
- Turn-off your audio and camera, if you do not want your personal data appearing into audio and video recording.

3. For which purpose do we process your data?

The primary purpose of the collection of personal data is for the organisation and management of the given event, in particular for processing registration requests and sending appropriate information to participants such as web-links of the event as well as for the collection of feedback after the event through a survey. Participants may also submit any questions to the Agency via the Webex chat box available during the meeting.

In addition, the purpose of the processing is also for:

- Recording of the event and publication: the event will be audio and video recorded for the
 purpose of sharing experience and will be published on the EACEA website. We will record
 on video speakers' presentations and their answers to participants' questions. When asking or
 replying questions, participants can either use video and/or audio or the chat function in
 Webex. If they choose to voluntarily use video and/or audio, participants will be recorded
 accordingly.
- Invitations to future similar events (upon consent) that EACEA may organise: EACEA will send you information on future similar events during a period of 5 years.

4. Who has access to your personal data and to whom is it disclosed?

Access to your personal data may be given on a need-to know basis to the following recipients:

- EACEA: Staff members of the unit of the controller, Director and Heads of Department,
- European Commission: relevant DGs in particular the Directorate-General for Education, Youth, Sport and Culture (DG EAC), Directorate-General for Neighbourhood and Enlargement Negotiations (DG NEAR) and Directorate-General for International Partnerships (DG INTPA).
- The third-party tool (Webex) used will be processing your data for the purpose of organising and managing the event.
- Vimeo may will process your personal data according to its privacy statement when the recording will be published: https://vimeo.com/privacy
- The general public will have access to the recording once it is published

In case of control or dispute, the bodies charged with a monitoring or inspection task in application of Union law (e.g. Internal Audit Service, European Commission, OLAF, EU Courts etc.).

Upon consent of the data subjects:

• Recording of the event will be shared will be published on EACEA website.

For registration purpose, your personal data is collected and processed by **EU Survey**, in accordance with the relevant data protection notice of the Commission: https://ec.europa.eu/eusurvey/home/privacystatement

Please note that the event will be organised using **Webex**, which have a contract with the European Commission, and your personal data used for your participation to the event will also be processed by these Tools, in accordance with their privacy policy which can be found here: https://ec.europa.eu/info/sites/default/files/web_conference_privacy.2021_.pdf

Please note that in order to deliver the service, Webex might transfer your personal data outside the EU in accordance with its privacy policy (mentioned above). Such transfer will be made based on standard contractual clauses as part of a contract between the service provider and the European Commission. You can obtain more information on it by contacting the data controller at the above mentioned email address.

Please note that in order to deliver its service, Vimeo might transfer your personal data outside the EU in accordance with their privacy policies (Vimeo privacy statement) and will act as separate controller in this respect. Concerning Vimeo, please note that the protection of your personal data will depend on the law and practice of the third country, which might offer a lower level of protection of their personal data compared to the EU legislation, in particular with regard to the risks of legally binding requests from public authorities to the third party following the invalidation of the Privacy Shield.

5. How long do we keep your personal data?

Mandatory data relating to the Registration process of the event will be kept for 4 years after the closure of the event.

However, we may keep information identifying you for a longer period for historical, statistical or scientific purposes with the appropriate safeguards in place.

Video and audio recording will be kept for 2 years after the date of event.

Personal data kept upon consent for **invitations to future similar events** that EACEA may organise will be kept for 5 years after the date of event.

6. What are your rights concerning your personal data and how can you exercise them?

Under the provisions of the data protection regulation, you have the right to:

- Request to access the personal data EACEA holds about you;
- Request a rectification of your personal data where necessary;
- Request the erasure of your personal data;
- Request the restriction of the processing of your personal data.

For the processing of your personal data which is based on public interest under of Article 5(1)(a) of the data protection regulation, please note that you have the right to object to processing of your personal data on grounds relating to your particular situation under the provisions of Article 23 of the data protection regulation.

For the processing of your personal data which is based on your consent, on your consent under Article 5(1)(d) of the data protection regulation, please note that you can withdraw it at any time, and this will have effect from the moment of your retraction. The processing based on your consent before its withdrawal will remain lawful.

You should also be informed that by virtue of Article 25 of the data protection regulation and of the Internal Rules laid down under Decision of the Steering Committee on internal rules concerning restrictions of certain rights of data subjects in relation to the processing of personal data in the framework of activities carried out by the European Education and Culture Executive Agency dated 22 October 2020 (published on the Official Journal:

One or several of these rights may be restricted for a temporary period inter alia on the grounds of prevention, investigation, detection and prosecution of criminal offences.

7. Your right to have recourse in case of conflict on any personal data issue

8. On which legal basis are we processing your personal data?

The Processing of your personal data is based on the following legal basis:

Art. 5(1)(a) processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the Union institution or body (to be laid down in Union Law):

- For collecting and processing your data for the purpose of organising and managing the event, including the collection of feedback after the event through a survey. Provision and processing of these personal data is mandatory to attend to the event.
- For processing of your personal data using the above-mentioned third party tool(s) used to organise the event
- For speakers: for the recording and publication of the session on the EACEA website.

The applicable legal basis under Art. 5(1)(a) are:

- The Commission Implementing Decision 2021/173 establishing the European Education and Culture Executive Agency;
- The Commission Decision C (2021)951 and its annexes delegating powers to EACEA for the management of programmes in the MFF 2021-2027.
- Regulation (EU) 2021/817 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 May 2021 establishing Erasmus+: the Union Programme for education and training, youth and sport and repealing Regulation (EU) No 1288/2013 (Text with EEA relevance).

Art. 5(1)(d) the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes:

For participants: for Audio and Video recording of the event and sharing with other projects' representatives and DGs through the EACEA website. By registering with their personal email when joining the Webex session and activating their microphone/camera, or when

submitting questions via the chat, the data subject provides its consent to the recording and publication of his/her personal data as part of the recording of this session.

- Invitations to future similar events organised by EACEA.

If you do not want your personal data appearing into the audio and video recording and being published on the EACEA website, you may switch-off your audio and camera or decide not to do intervene in the online discussion.

Participation to the event is not conditional to your consents above. You may provide, to the extent possible, anonymised data to register using a corporate email address without name e.g. contact@companyname.com.
