School Education Gateway Last update of this record (where applicable) N/A Short description of the processing The School Education Gateway is an online platform for school education where anyone can register. Presented in 23 European languages, the School Education Gateway is a single point of entry targeting teachers, school leaders, policy makers, experts and other professionals in the school education field. Personal data are provided by the users themselves by submitting online forms in various areas of the School Education Gateway platform, in order to participate to the activities (such as taking part in the online courses or submit listings) and to be able to use all the features of the platform (such as commenting articles, adding items in favourites, or saving searches). School Education Gateway is an initiative of the European Union. It is funded by Erasmus+, the European programme for Education, Training, Youth and Sport. Agency.

The processing of data is necessary to:

- Allow registrants to use platform services such as:
 - o posting comments, reviews and listings;
 - o using different platform features such as favourites or saved searches; and
 - o enriching the user profiles.
- Be able to handle helpdesk inquiries, content suggestions, reported items, etc.;
- To allow School Education Gateway registrants to communicate and collaborate in the spirit of mutual trust and respect;
- Allow and facilitate monitoring and research activities;
- Develop outreach and communication purposes within the framework of the School Education Gateway platform and its services;
- Send the users updates and relevant information (i.e. newsletter) related to School Education Gateway, and to inform users of other related activities they might be interested in within European Commission initiatives;
- Enable online course administration and implementation including:
 - tracking attendance to training courses, progress and completion of modules by individual users;
 - sharing personally identifiable information and performance in a given online course with the instructors or moderators who teach the course or are part of running the course;
 - allowing users to contribute to the online courses through rating, comments, bookmarks, tagging, completing quizzes, taking part in forums and other communication tools, and uploading their own resources;
 - presenting and summarising outcomes of a course;
 - o reuse and reference posts in forums and communication tools in ongoing and future versions of the courses and course communications, and to enhance future course offerings:
 - organising users into group or themed-based activities.
- Enable and improve the user experience within this and potential similar future projects developed by the European Commission via user access control, tracking usage frequency, search behaviours, preferences and settings;
- Allow for collection, categorization and summary of user contributions in the forums and other discussion tools;
- Provide aggregated statistics, including, but not limited to, the number of users during a specific period, the preferred subjects and/or countries chosen by members and account usage.

10	Retention time (time limit for keeping the personal data)
	Indicate the period of storage:
	Data related to the account and profile of the user are kept for three years after the user's last login. After three years from the last login, the user profile will automatically be set to inactive, i.e., no longer visible to other users. A notification is sent to the user to inform her/him that her/his account has been set to inactive and that he/she can re-activate his/her account by logging in again within two weeks. If the user does not login within two weeks, his/her account and profile will be deactivated permanently. All personal information linked to the user account is then made anonymous. Any personal data the user may have inserted through third-parties tools (e.g. during an online course when using an external online tool, such as Facebook, Twitter or Padlet) is not under the responsibility of the data controller and is therefore not concerned with the anonymization.
	In case users ask for the deactivation of their account or the account is automatically deactivated, no data will be visible to other School Education Gateway users. Data will be kept only in an anonymous form that does not allow for personal identification. If users with a deactivated account want to continue using the platform, they will need to register again. The data remain solely for research and monitoring purposes at the disposal of the EACEA, the European Commission, national or regional school authorities, authorities in charge of implementing School Education Gateway and other third parties under the authorisation of the data controller in an aggregated format.

	Some data submitted by users will be displayed on the public area of the School Education Gateway platform, which means that such data is freely accessible on the Internet. In this case the user has the right to delete their data. The data which becomes public is in particular the following:

- Organisation data is visible to all users through the organisation's page:
 - Name, address, city, country, picture, Facebook URL, Twitter URL, LinkedIn URL and website
 - o Registrants affiliated to the organisation (first name, last name, country, picture)
 - Courses, Mobility Opportunities and Strategic Partnership listings posted by the members of the organisation
 - Star rating based on the average score of the organisation's courses (if any)
 - List of reviews and ratings submitted by other users on the organisation's courses

• Registrant data:

- The following registrant data is visible to all users only at the public organisation page (if the user is affiliated to one or several organisations): first name, last name, country, a thumbnail of the picture (if provided)
- User's profile page is accessible only to other logged in users, including the following information: first name, last name, country, picture, organisation(s), user type, comments made by the registrant, articles favorited by the member, and if the registrant is eTwinning verified.
- Any listing, comment, review and/or rating voluntarily made by a registered user is public, i.e. visible to the website users when viewing the commented or reviewed item and also retrievable through search engines.
- User activity on the online courses is viewable only by the registered users who have also signed up to the specific online course.

13 General description of security measures

The collected personal data and all related information are stored on secured servers of the service provider (European Schoolnet).

A contractual clause about data protection is included in the contract with the service provider, to ensure that their data are processed in compliance with the applicable legislation.

The operations of the service provider's computer centres contractually abide to the European Commission's security directives and provisions established by the Directorate of Security for these kinds of servers and services.
