Lot 1: The Alliances for Education and Enterprises

- Merging the classical SSAs with the KAs of the previous programme
- Sectoral or Cross-Sectoral
- Labour Market and non-labour market
- HE, VET, Enterprises (business, but also e.g. non-profit enterprises)
- Skills, but also entrepreneurial mind-sets and social entrepreneurship

Objectives

- New approaches to teaching and learning
- Corporate Social responsibility
- Entrepreneurial attitudes, mindsets and skills
- Quality and relevance of skills – new skills, tackling skills mismatches, emerging professions
- Co-creation of knowledge
- Building HE and VET systems that are connected and inclusive – contributing to innovation

Activities

- Boosting innovation
- Developing a sense of initiative and entrepreneurial mind-sets, competences and skills
- Stimulating the flow and exchange of knowledge between HE, VET, enterprised and research
- Identifying resilience-related, market needs and emerging professions
- NB: deep tech as a possible project application activity

Lot 1

- Call 2021 – 300 applications!!! 25 projects selected under Lot One.
- Call 2022 – 369 applications!!! 25 projects selected under Lot One.
- 30 million EUR en 2023 (deadline: 3rd May 2023, 17hr CET)
- 1 million EUR – two year projects
- 1,5 million EUR – three year projects
- 4 Programme Countries, Minimum of 8 full partners
- Partnership: 3 labour market bodies (e.g. a business); 3 education or training providers
- In each proposal there has to be a minimum of one HE institution AND one VET provider as full partners

Expected Impact

- VET and HE cooperation
- Knowledge triangle, innovation capacity (deep tech)
- Regional eco-systems, SSS
- Target societal and economic challenges: eg climate change, green skills and economy, digitalisation, artificial intelligence
- As such taking into account Agenda 2030 SDGs, Paris Declaration on Climate Change, Green Deal, Europe Recovery Plan
