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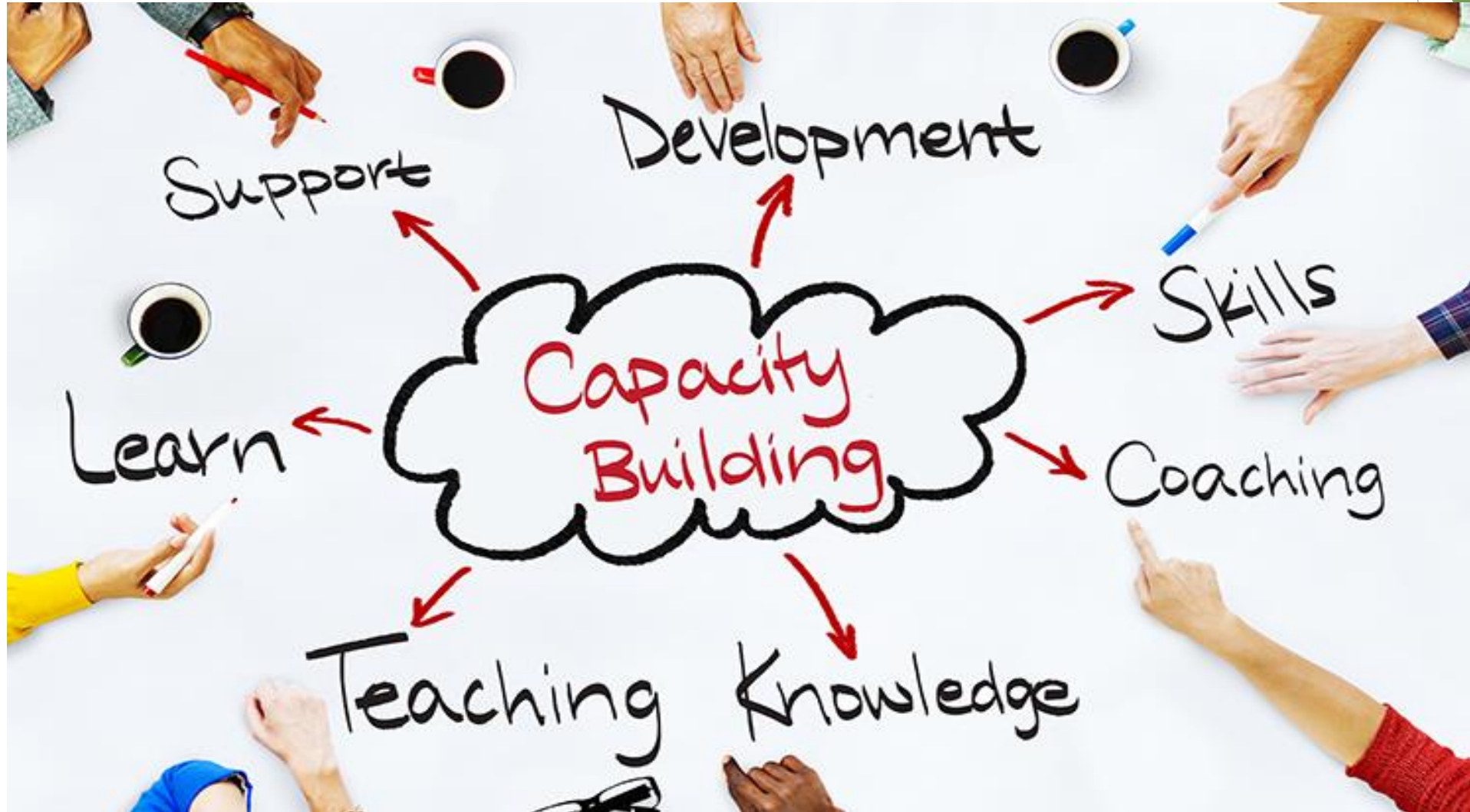

## *Focus on Third Countries*

**Focus on the needs** of the third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme

**Targeting the priorities** of the third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme and matching them with the EU priorities for these countries

**Maximising benefit** to third countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme

# What is it about?

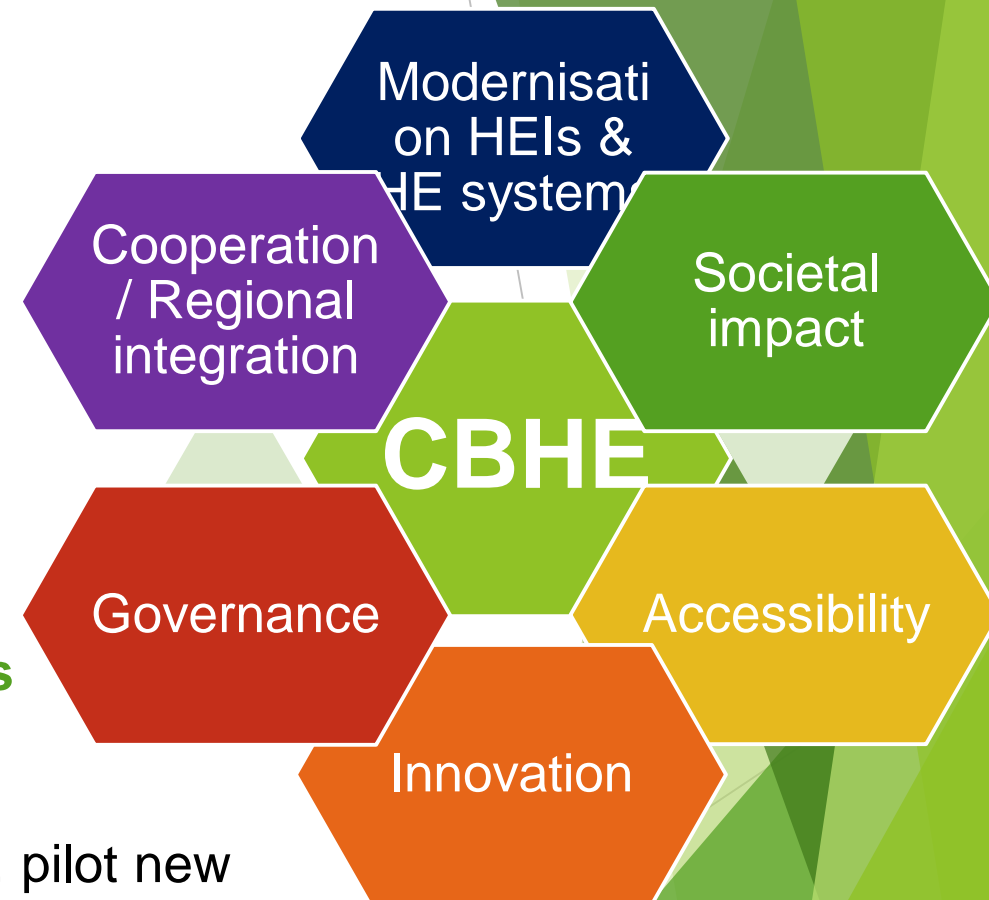
- Transnational **cooperation** projects, based on multilateral **partnerships**, mainly between **higher education institutions (HEIs)** from EU Member States/E+ Associated Countries and third countries (e.g. EU and LA).
- General objective: Supports the **quality** and **modernization** and response capacity of **HEIs** and educational systems of third countries, but not only



# What is it about ?

## Objectives

- Ensures **equity, accessibility** and **inclusion**, system strengthening and **capacity building**, as well as **employability** transversally across the action.
- **Global interventions** that take into account governance, management and the **strengthening of higher education's wider economic and social ecosystems**.
- Addresses **regional issues**, build alliances and coalitions, pilot new approaches and initiatives built on **country ownership**.



# What is it about?

## *Latin America and Caribbean Regions*

Regional integration

Improved access to and quality of higher education, in particular for people with fewer opportunities and in the poorest areas of the different countries

Internationalisation: increased capacity and professionalism to work at international level



# What is it about?

## *Expected impact*

### Individual level:

Intercultural contacts, improvement of the level of competences/skills of the academic/administrative staff, Students

### Higher Education Institutions level:

Development of study programs Modernization of the governance, management..

### National: Education System level

# Types of CBHE projects: *Three Strands*

**Strand 1** - Fostering access to cooperation in Higher Education

24 o 36 months

EUR 200.000- EUR 400.000

- Facilitate access to newcomers
- Reach out to people with fewer opportunities
- Reduce the internationalisation gap of HEIs from the same country/region
- Fostering social inclusion

**Strand 2** - Partnerships for transformation

24 o 36 months

EUR 400.000- EUR 800.000

- Complex and innovative capacity building projects based on a transfer of experience, competencies and good practice
- Innovation in higher education
- Promoting reform in HEIs

**Strand 3** - Structural Reform projects

36 o 48 months

EUR 800.000- EUR1.000.000

- Involvement of the Ministry
- Structural improvement and innovation at the level of the higher education sector



# Types of CBHE projects:

## *Three Strands - Activities*

**Strand 1** -Fostering access to cooperation in Higher Education

Type of Activities

- Reforming and modernising the university governance
- Strengthening international relations offices
- Building capacities to support (vulnerable) students and staff mobility

**Strand 2** - Partnerships for transformation

Type of Activities


- Development, testing and adaptation of innovative curricula linked to business
- Implementing new learning methods and schemes
- Modernising HEIs by promoting reform

**Strand 3** - Structural Reform projects

Type of Activities

- Promover reformas estructurales
- Proyectos nacionales posibles

<p>HEIs from 1 third country not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme</p> <p><b>Only Strand 3</b></p> 	<p>HEIs from several countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme from 1 Region (e.g. Argentina+El Salvador)</p>	<p>HEIs from countries not associated to the Erasmus+ Programme belonging to several Regions (e.g. Latin America + Caribbean)</p>
<p>At least 2 HEIs from two countries associated to Erasmus+ (EU Member States and other Programme countries) Specific eligibility criteria should be checked in the Programme Guide (per Region, Strand and type of project).</p>

## Who can apply?

- Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) or
- Associations or organisations of HEIs

## What else?

Applicant must be established in a EU Member state or third country associated to the Erasmus+ programme (*Programme Country*), or in an eligible third country not associated to Erasmus+ programme (*Partner Country*)

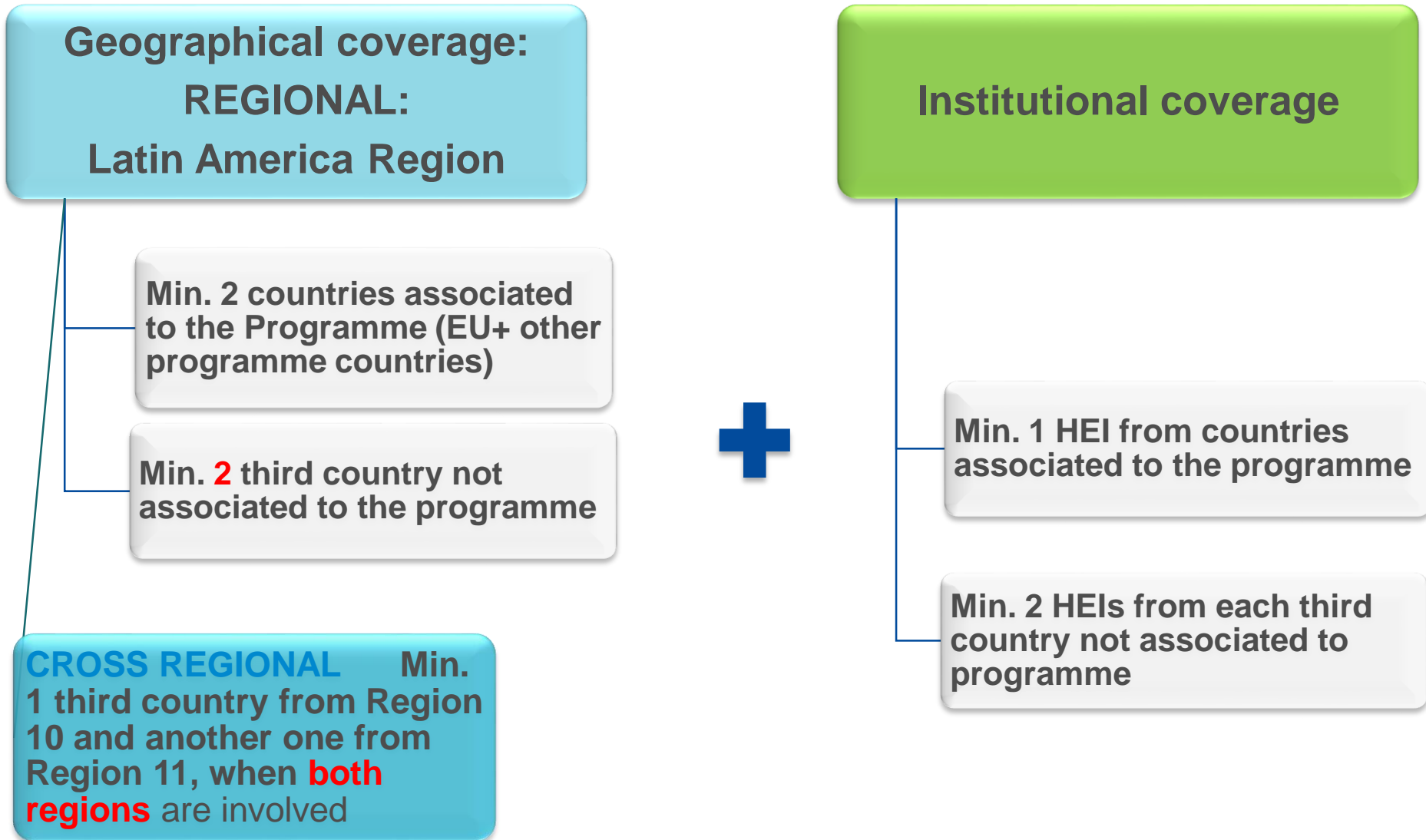
# Eligible partners

## What types of organisations are eligible?

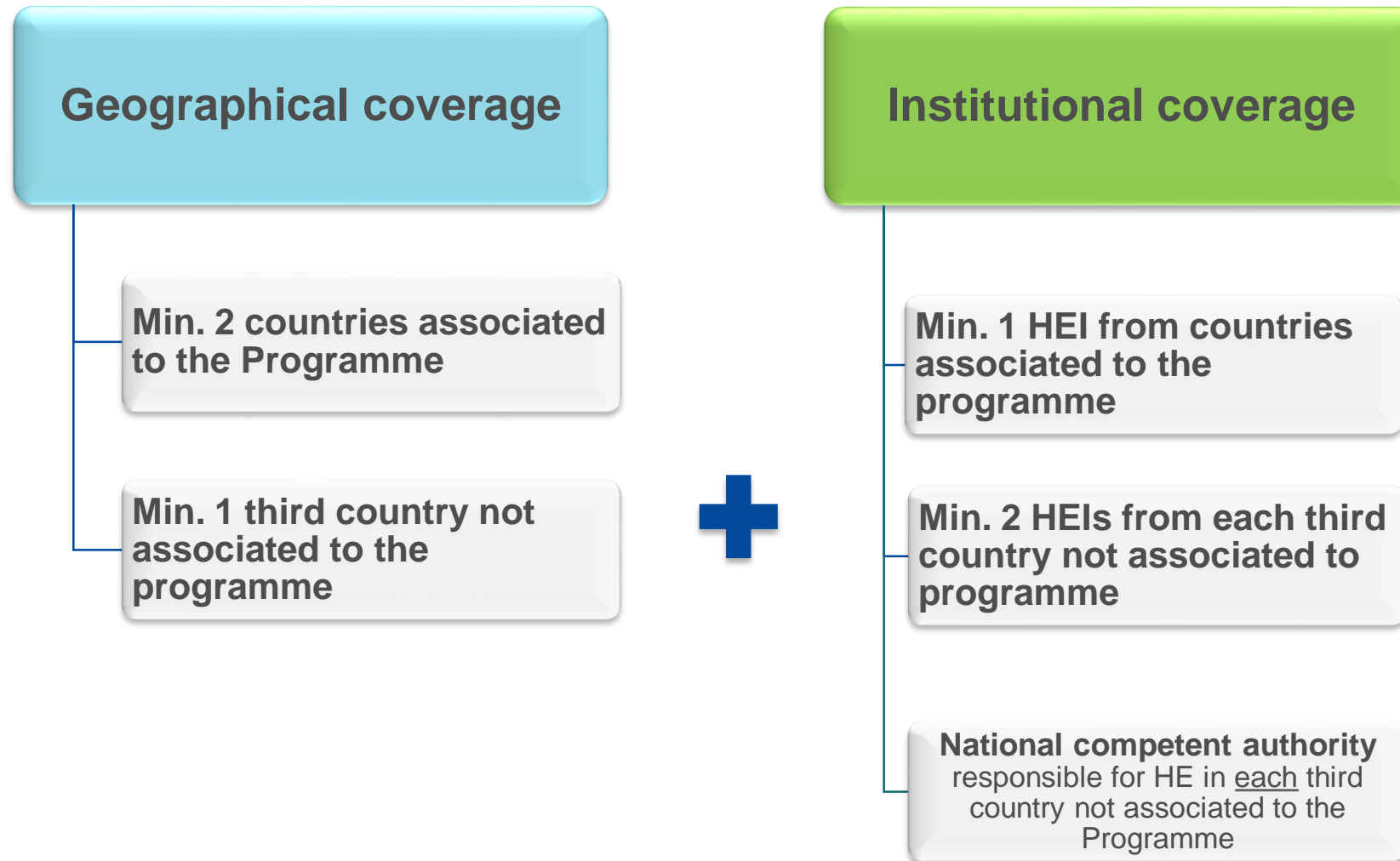
- any public or private organisation recognised as **HEI** by the competent authorities of their country(ies)
- any public or private organisation **active in the labour market or in the fields of education, training and youth**
- **Associations or organisations of HEIs** dedicated to the promotion, improvement and reform of higher education as well as to co-operation within Europe and between Europe and other parts of the world
- **International governmental organisations** on a self-financing basis.

# How to submit a proposal?

## ➤ Where?

Applications must be submitted through the [European Commission's Funding & Tender Opportunities Portal](https://ec.europa.eu/info/funding-tenders/opportunities/portal/screen/home) (F&TP) using the Portal Submission System:

## ➤ Who?

Proposals must be created and submitted by a contact person of the coordinating organization.

## ➤ When?

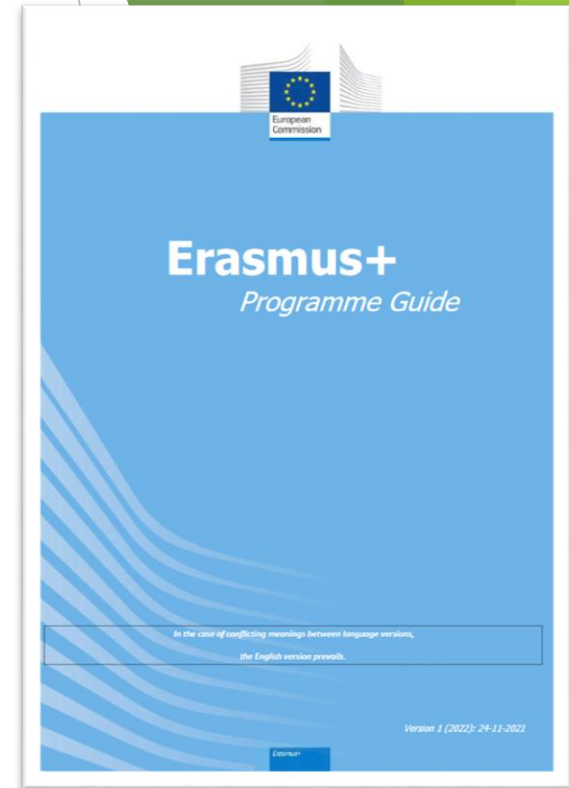
**Deadline: 16 February 2023 at 17:00**



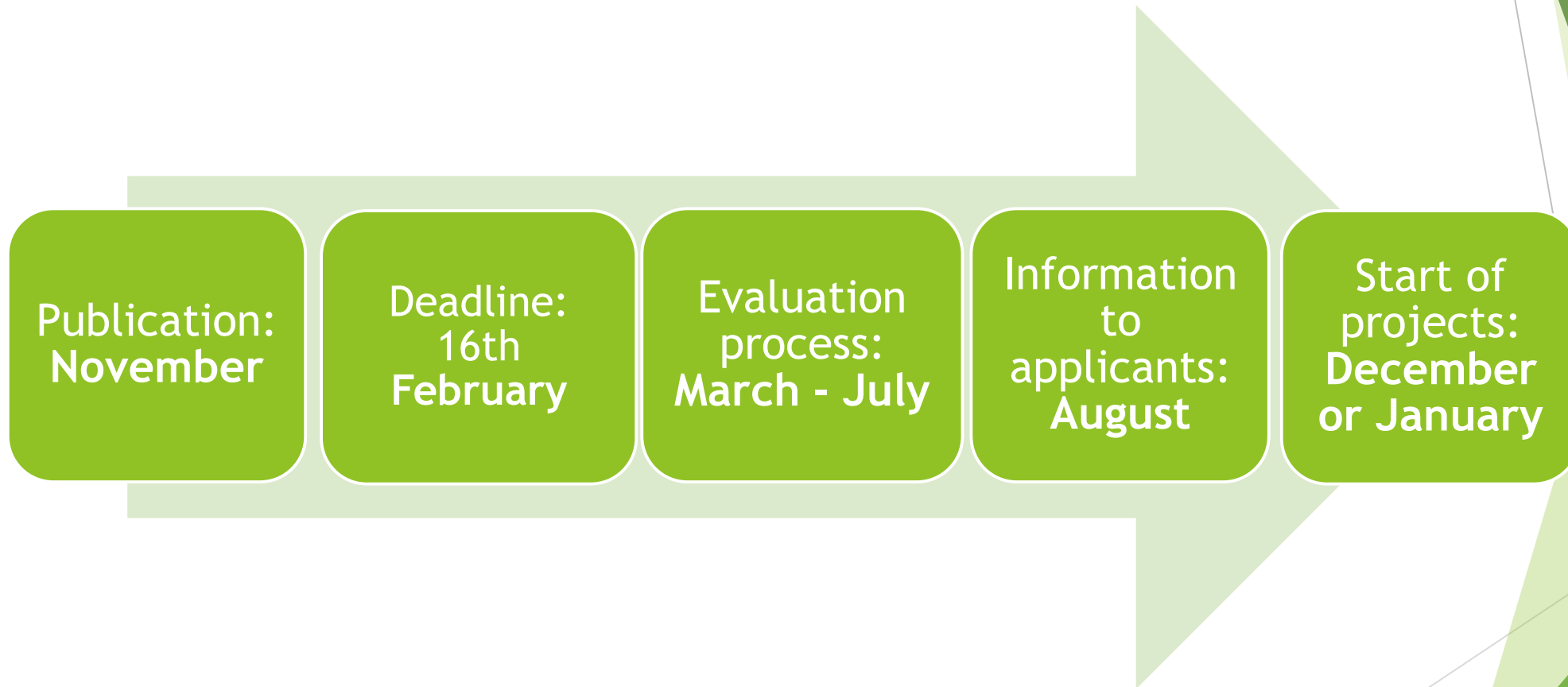
Applicants are highly recommended to submit proposals as early as possible and at least 48 hours prior to the call deadline.

# How to submit a proposal?

- Read carefully all the **call documents**: Erasmus+ Programme Guide, application templates and specific instructions published in the F&TP
- Read carefully the information on the Regional priorities published in FTOP.
- Plan your project and **define your work plan**: Work packages, milestones, deliverables
- Create an **EU Login account**: to be able to submit a proposal, you must register on the Portal for an EU Login account
- Make sure your organisation has a valid **Participant Identification Code (PIC)**. If not, get one via the Participant Register

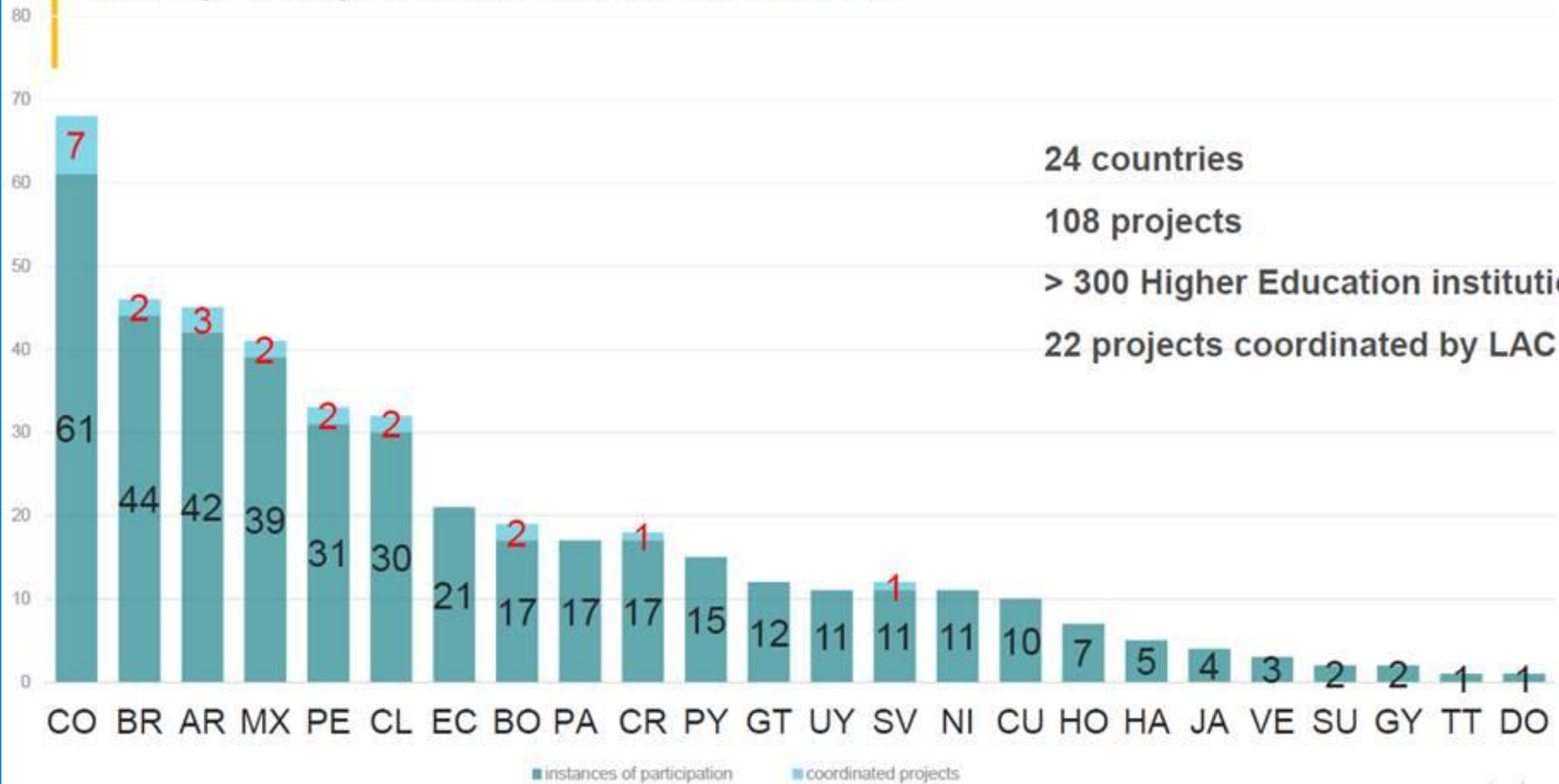


# Timeline of the annual call for proposals
