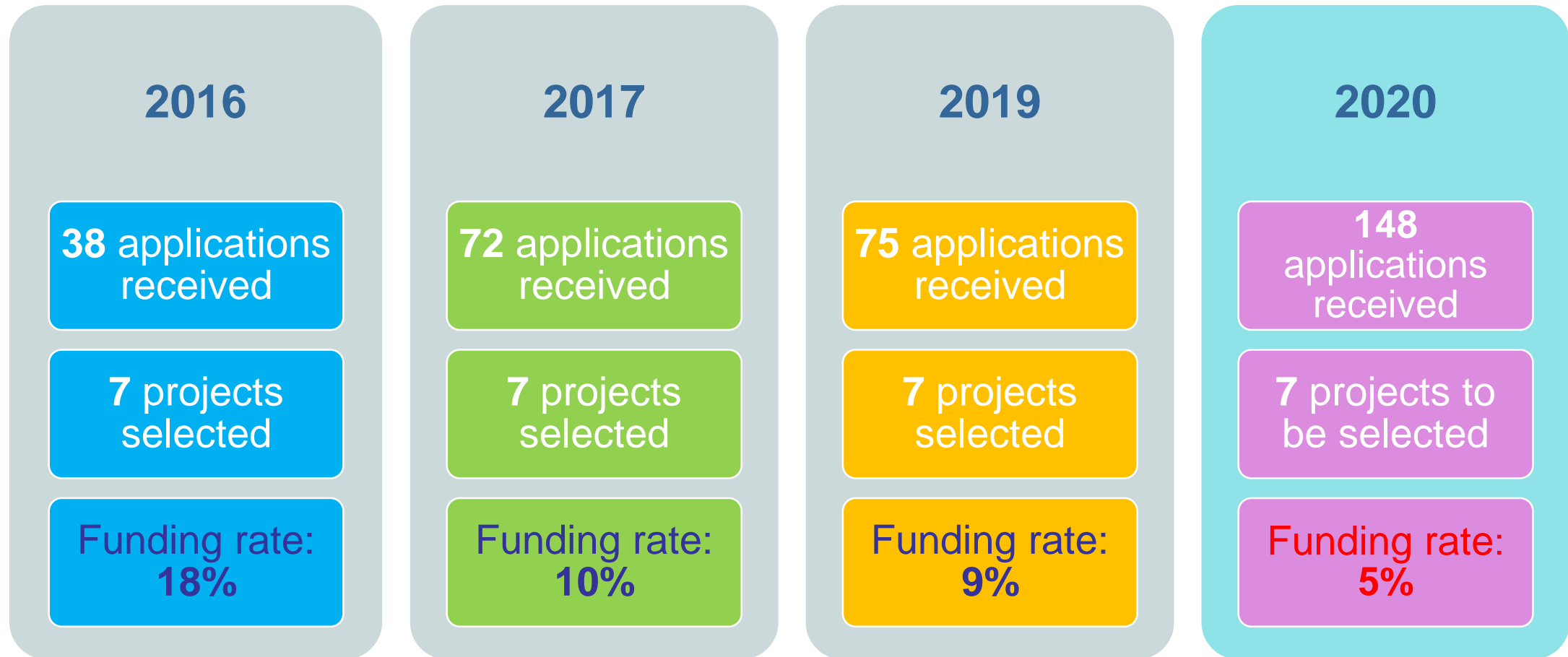

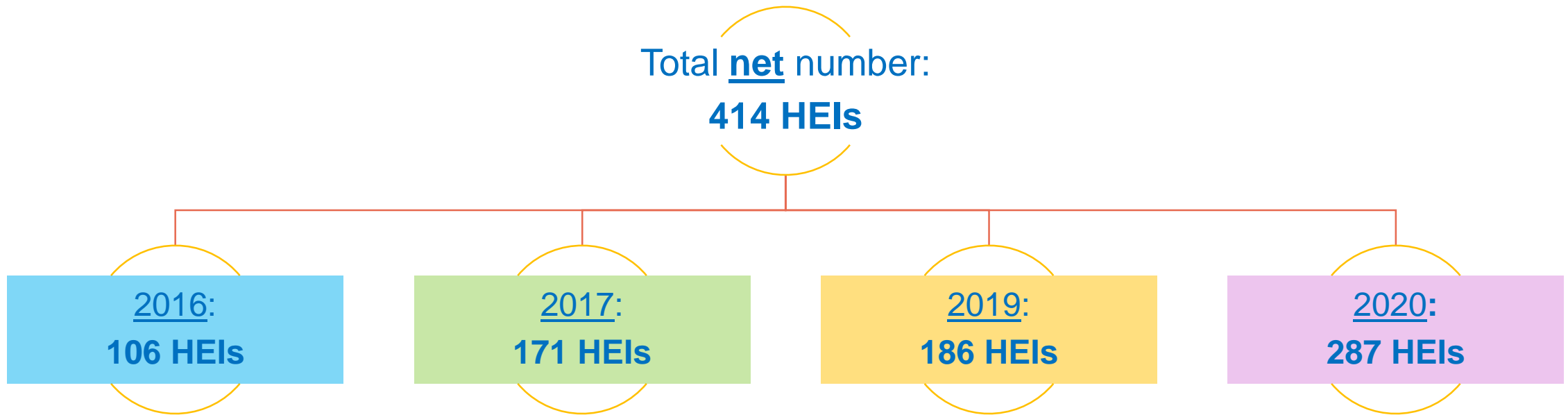

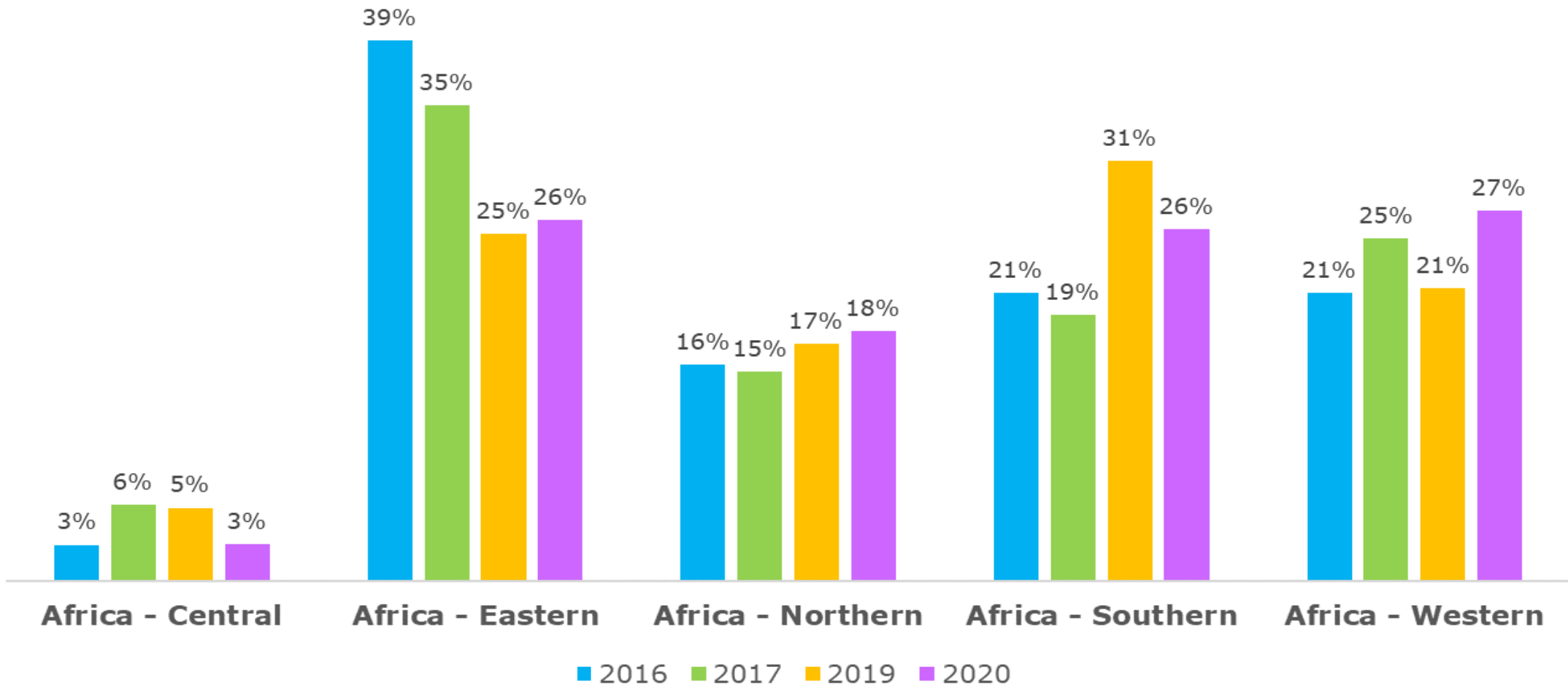
Call for proposals 2020 - proposals received



Total number of African HEIs (*Applicant and Partners*)



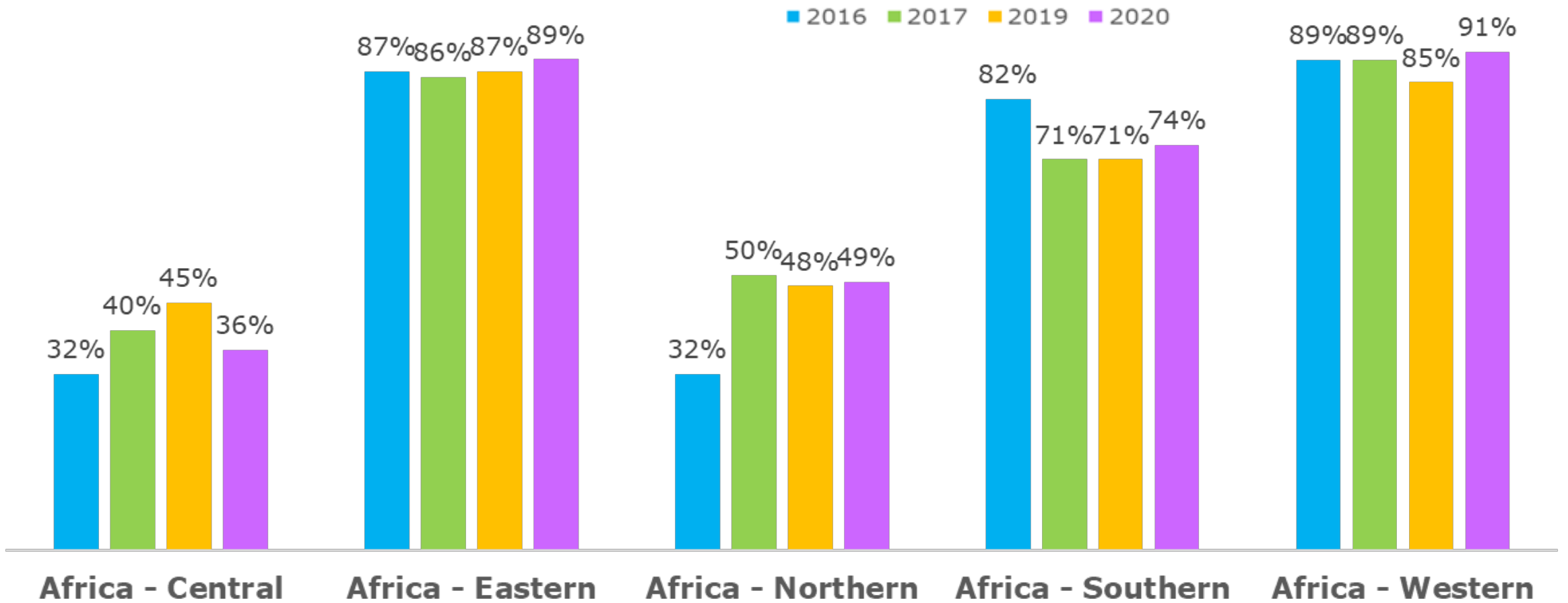
Percentage of proposals per region (Lead applicant)



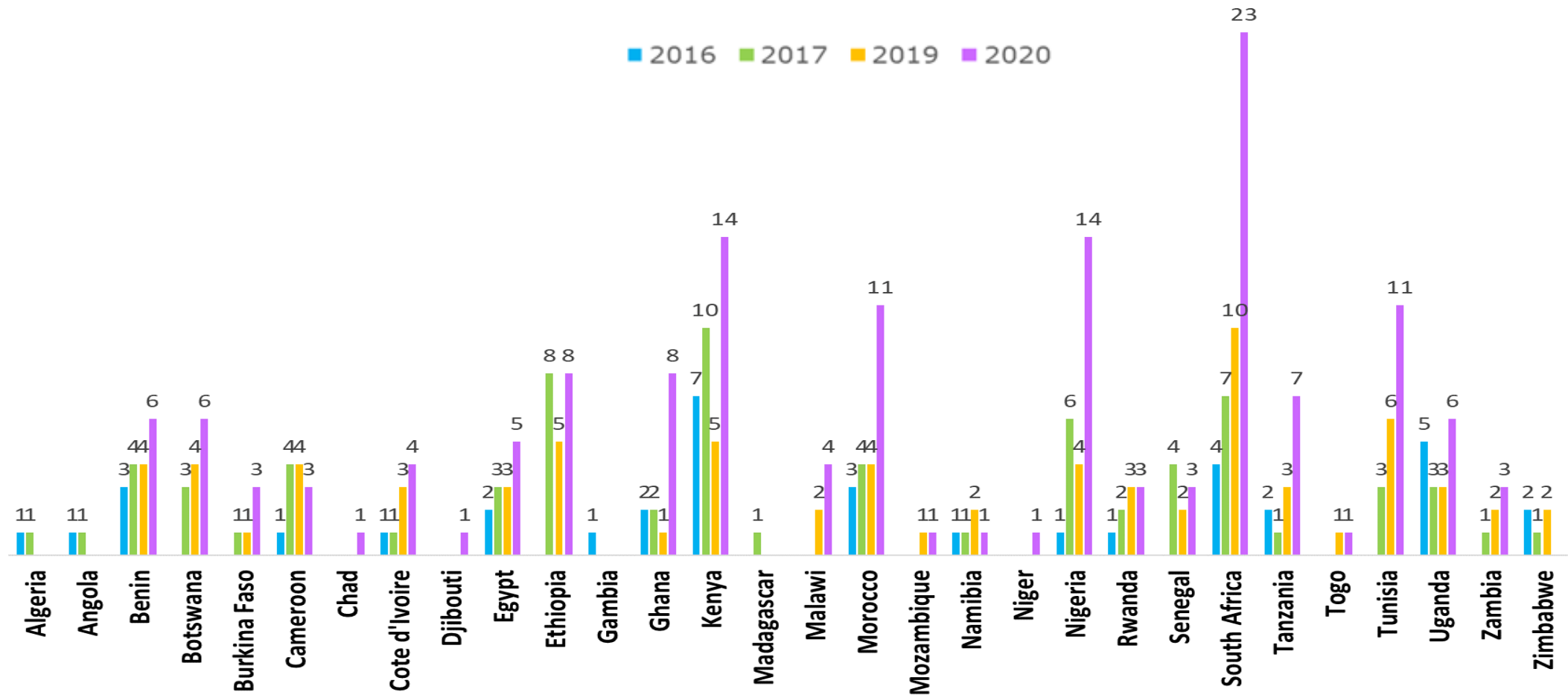

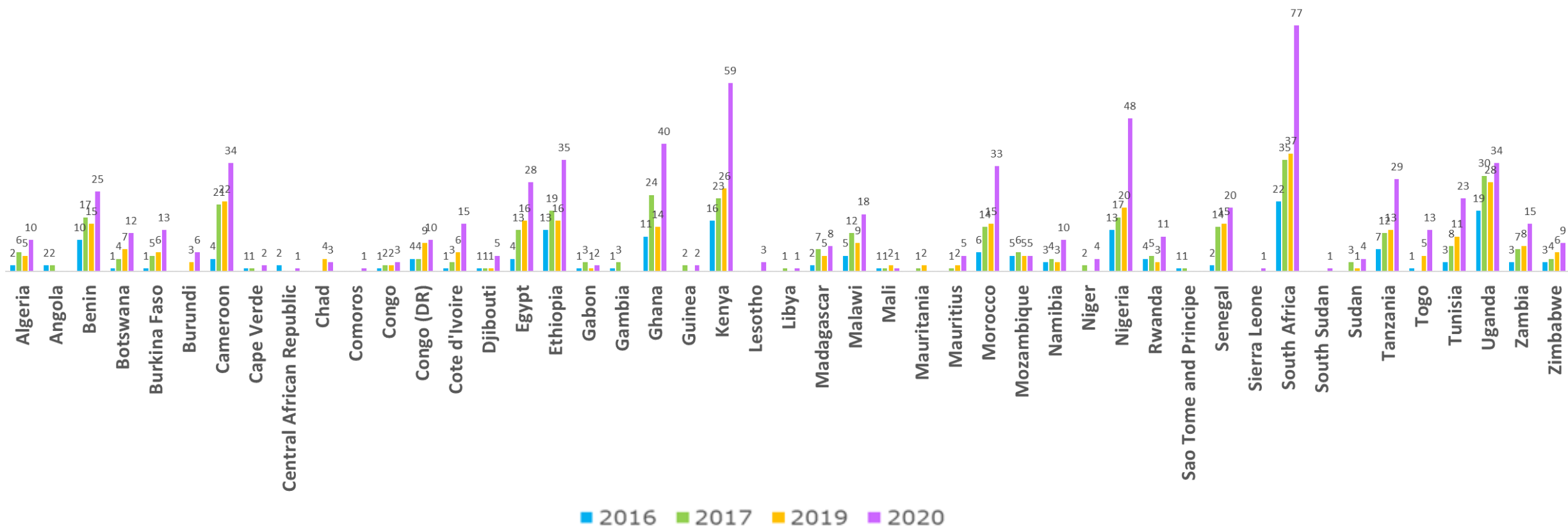
Percentage of proposals per region (Lead applicant and Partner)



Number of proposals per country of *Lead applicant*



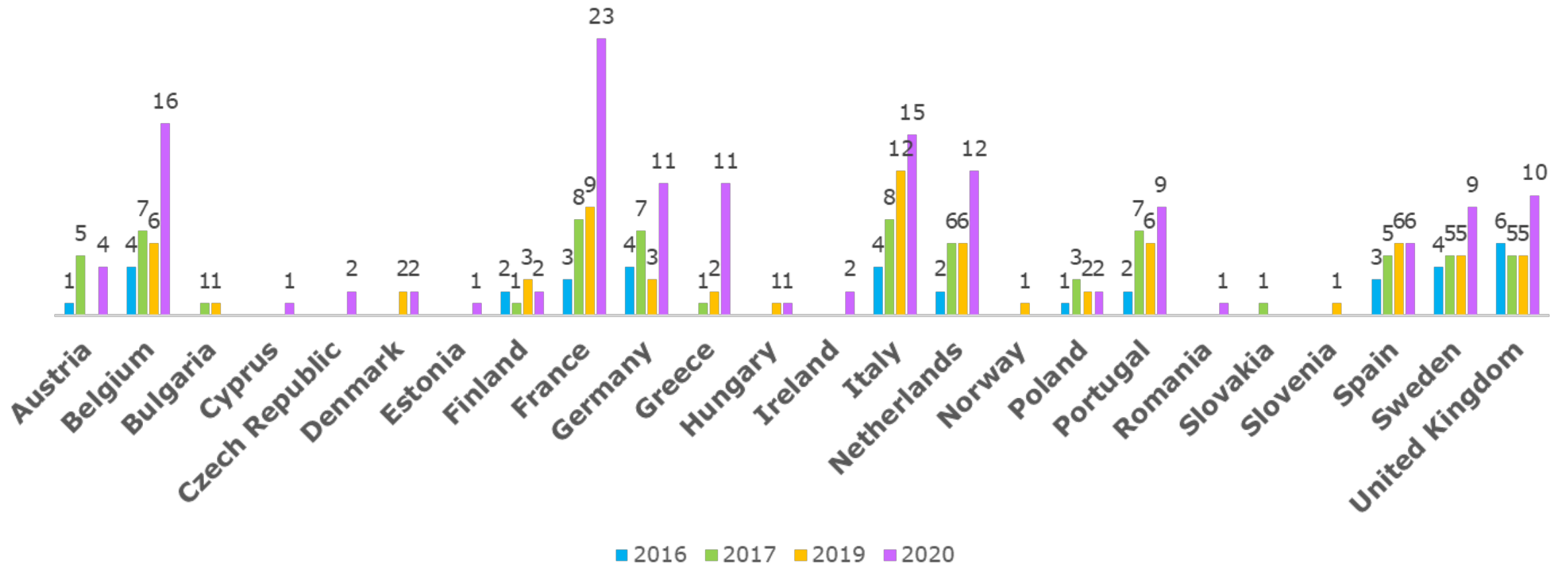
Number of proposals per country of African HEIs (Lead applicant and Partner)

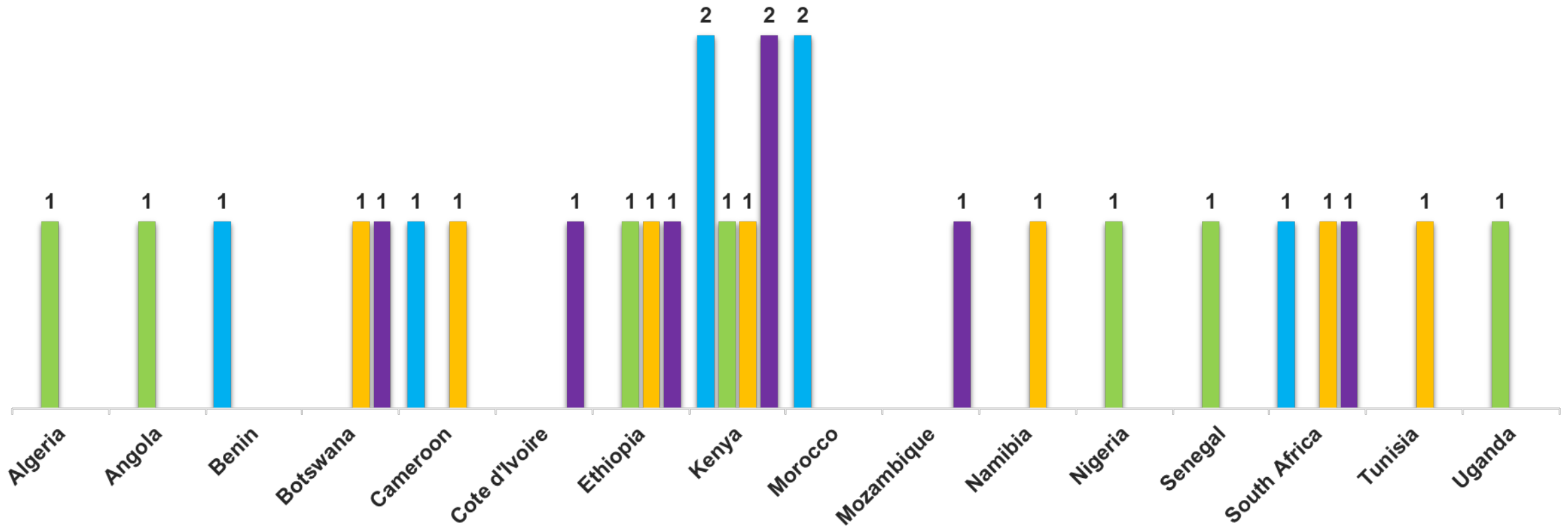

Number of projects per country of *Lead applicant*

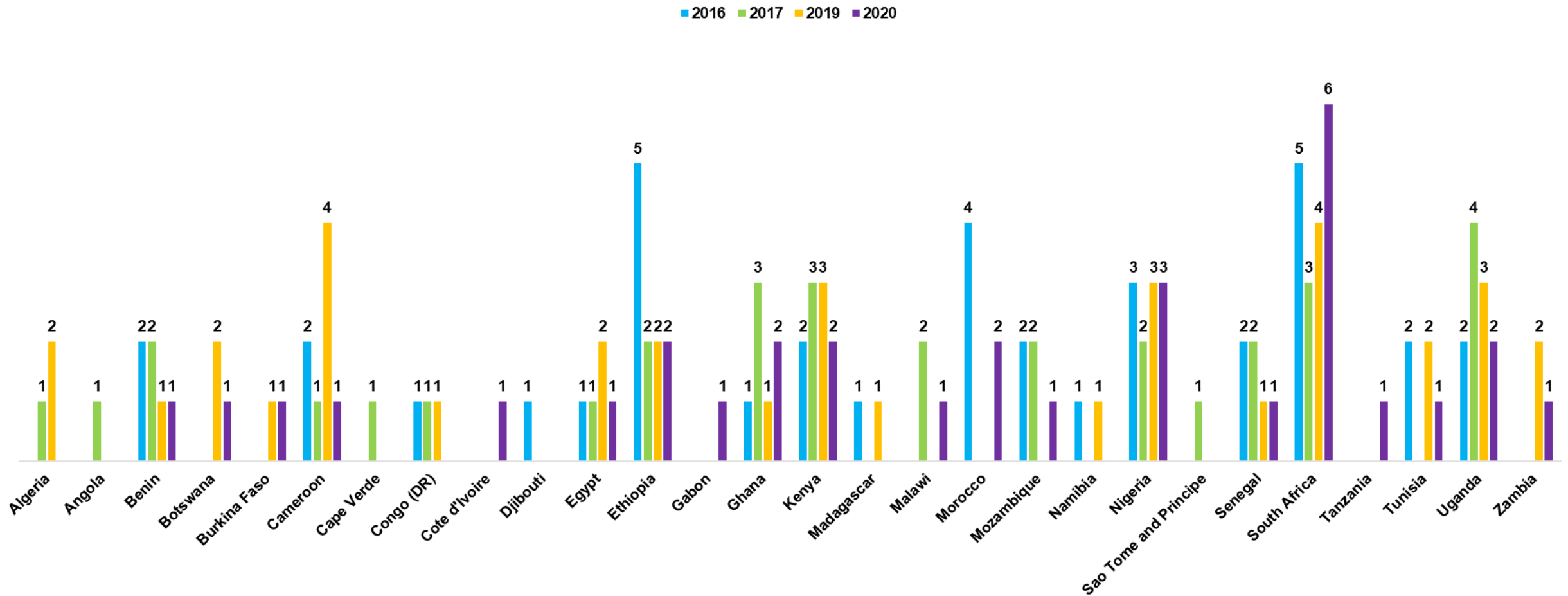

Number of projects per country of African HEIs (Lead applicant and Partner)

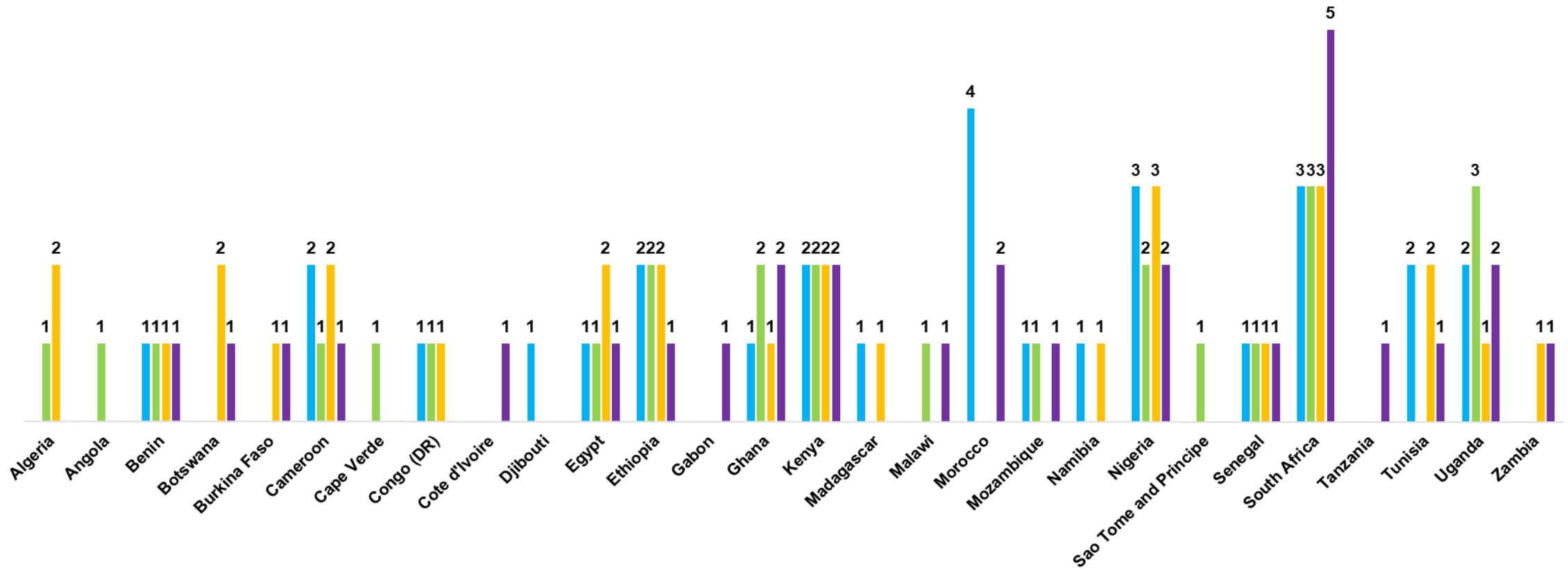

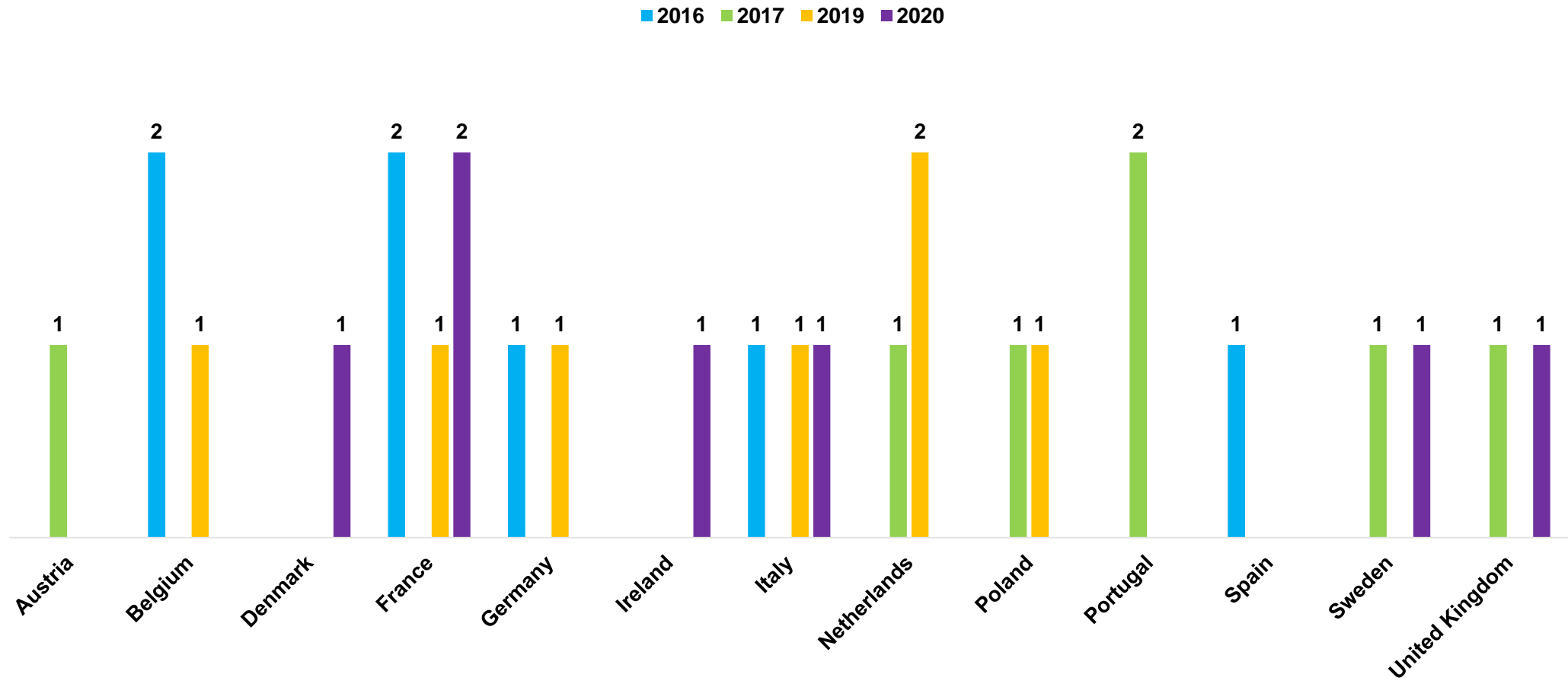

Conclusions

- **High competition and increased quality (threshold 78/100)**
- Increased **geographical coverage** with 3 new participating countries: Côte d'Ivoire, Gabon, Tanzania
- **Newcomers applicant countries and HEIs:**
 - 2 new coordinating countries out of 7 (Côte d'Ivoire, Mozambique)
 - 4 coordinating HEIs are newcomers
- Focus on the thematic priorities of STEM/ICT (4), Health (2) and Agriculture (1)
