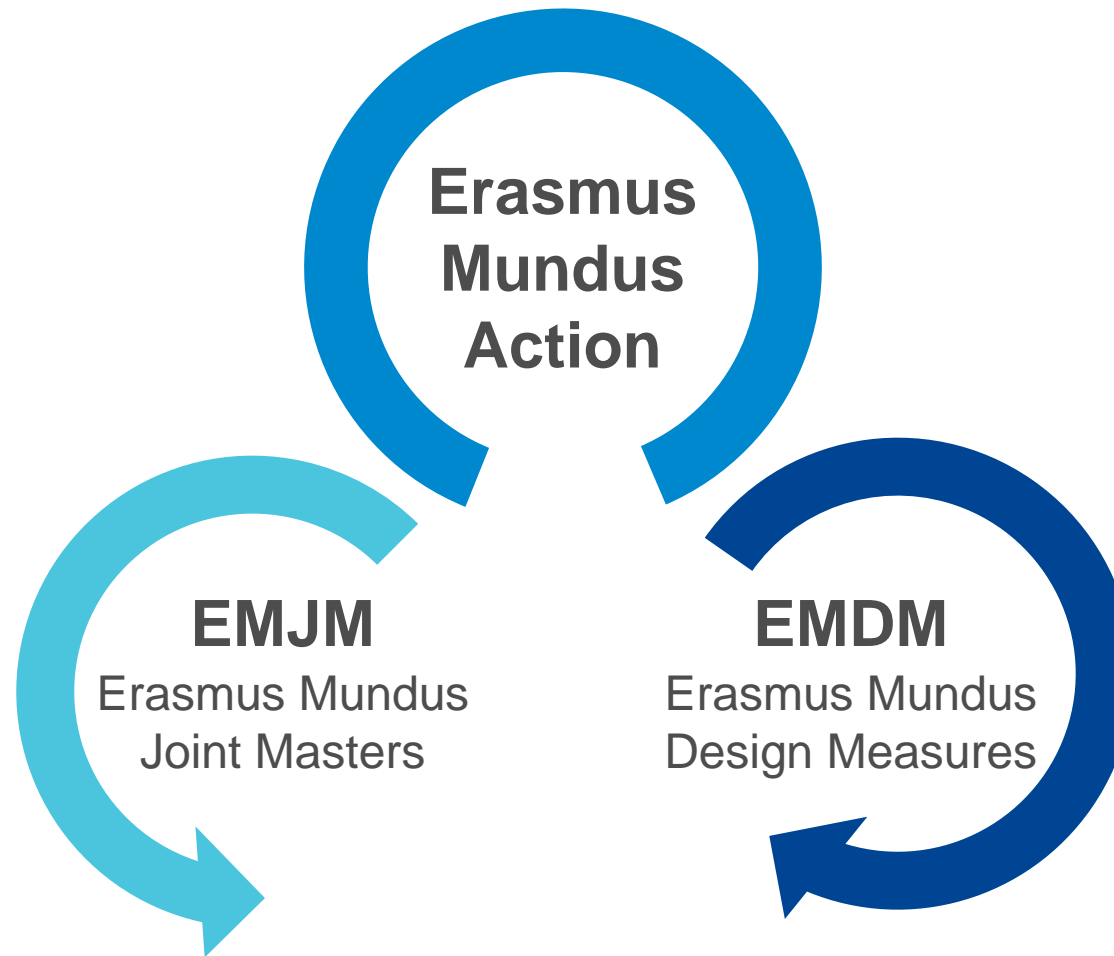

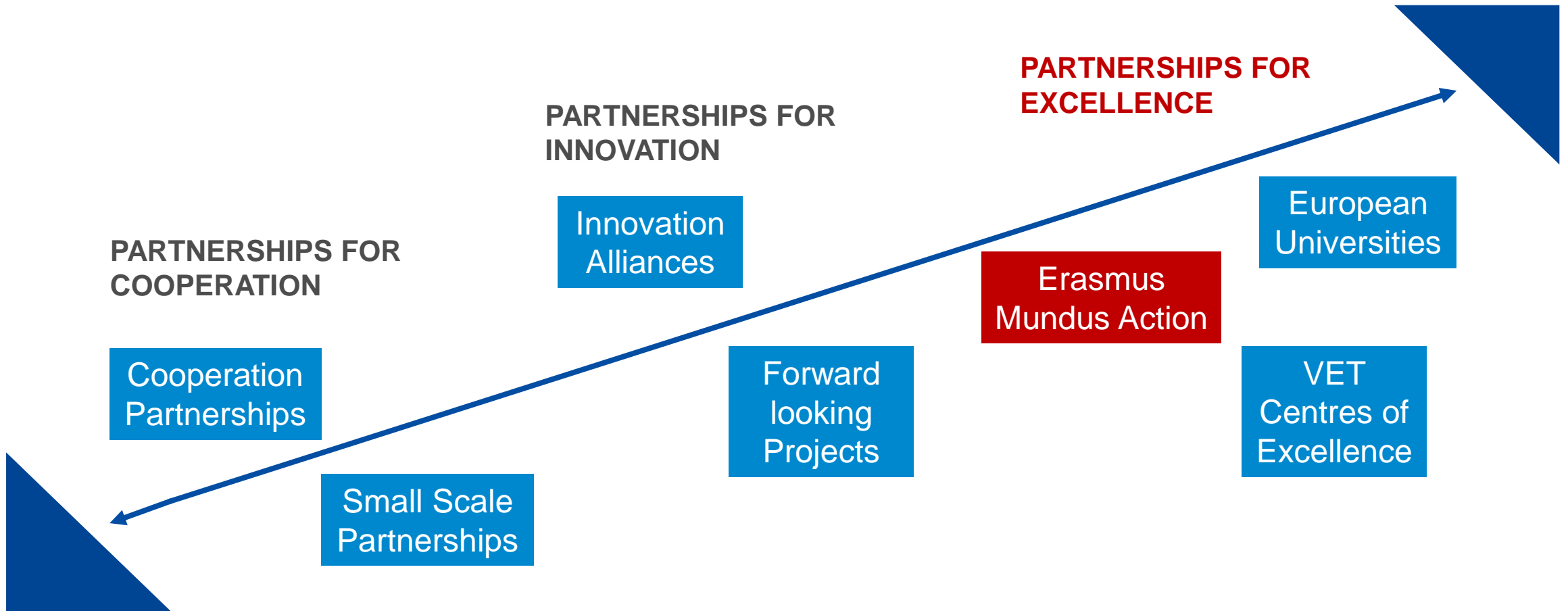

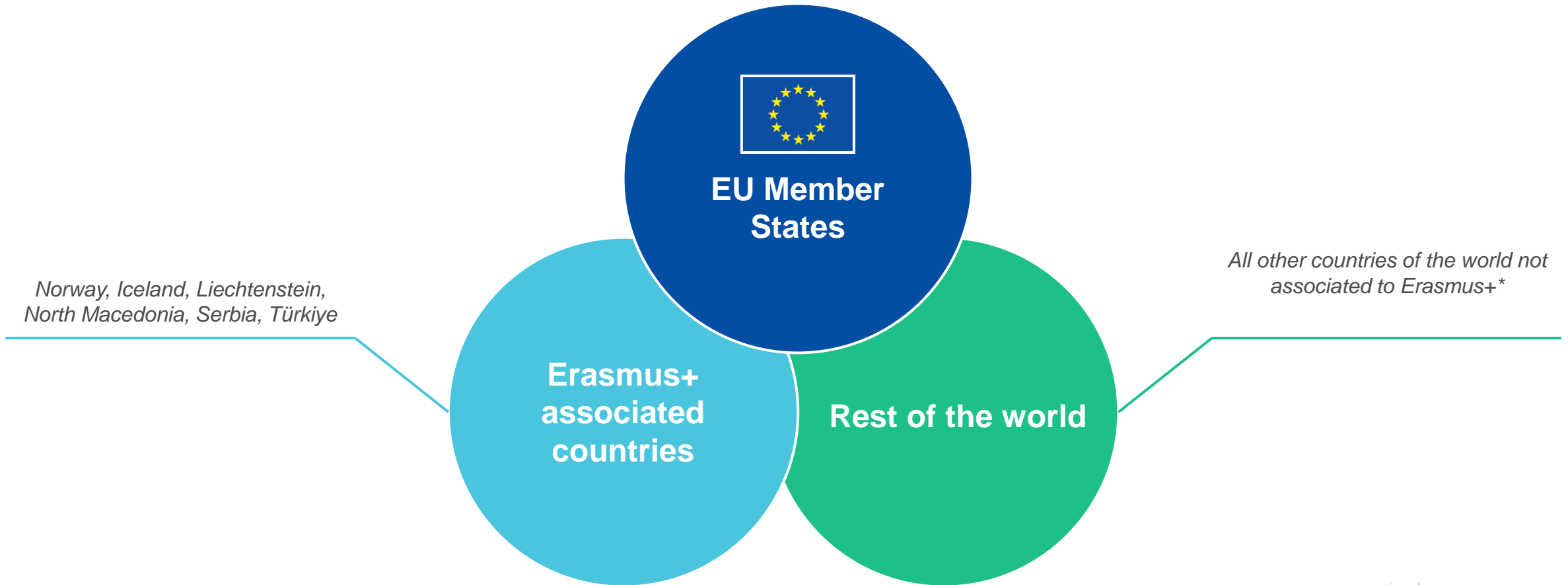

Rationale behind lot EMDM



Encourage the development of **innovative, highly integrated new international** study programmes at Master level **in partnership with universities worldwide**.

What is an EMDM project?



Short duration **grant of 15 months to support institutions** in the set-up of a new joint master programme in Europe and beyond



One beneficiary mobilising a group of other HEIs (mono-beneficiary grant)

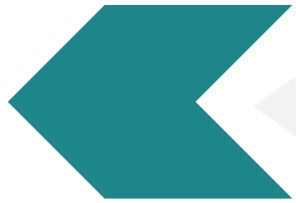


EU Grant: fixed **lump sum contribution of EUR 60,000** for costs linked to the activities necessary to set up the new joint master programme

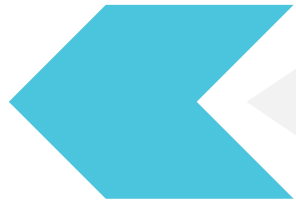


Independent funding scheme from EMJM (independent calls for proposals)

Expected outcomes of an EMDM (1)



Offer a **fully integrated curriculum delivered by a consortium** (involving at least three HEIs from three different countries, of which at least one from a EU Member State or third country associated to the programme **and one from a third country not associated to the Programme**)



Aim at **attracting excellent students** worldwide



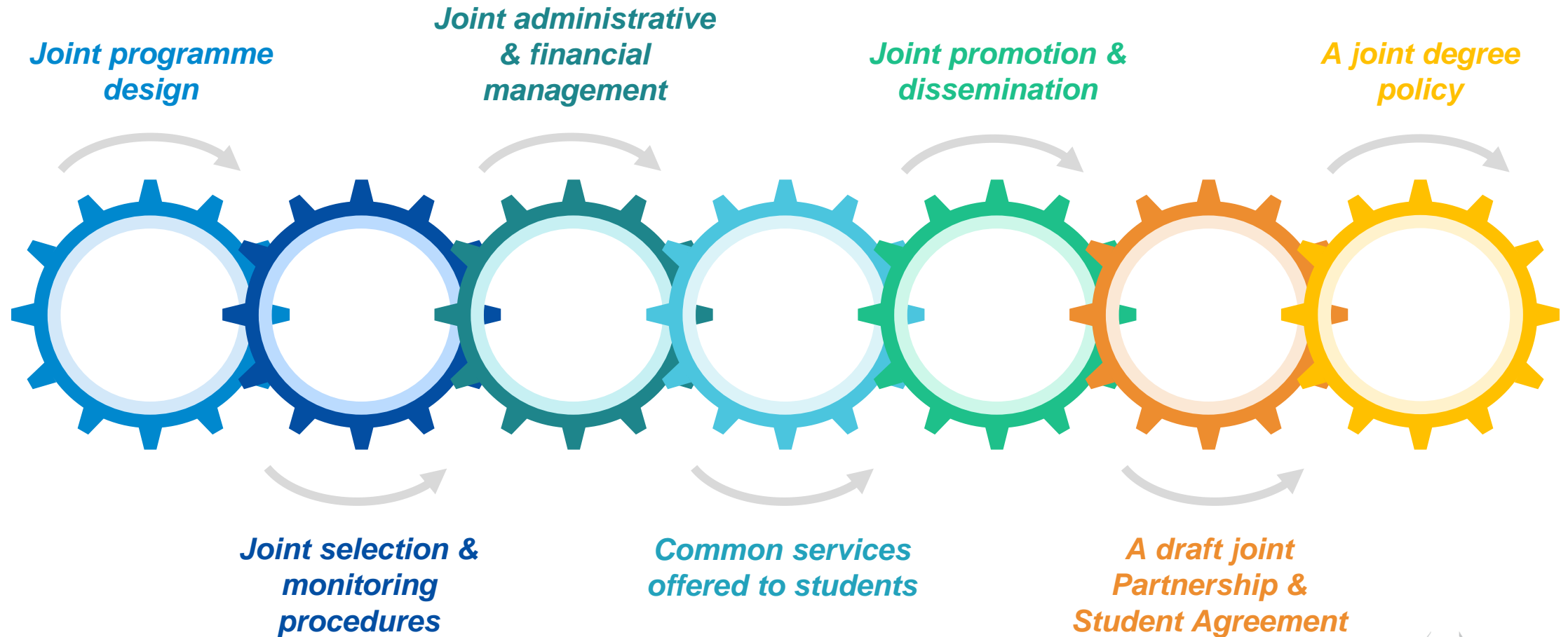
Include compulsory **physical mobility** for all recruited students



Lead to either a **Joint degree** or **multiple degrees**

Expected outcomes/deliverables of an EMDM (2)

- Joint mechanisms to be included in the design of the master programme



Taking part as an Organisation



Applications can **(only)** be submitted by any eligible HEI established in an EU Member State or third country associated to the Programme.

NEW



HEIs should be able to deliver a minimum level of education corresponding to **ISCED 7** (master level)



For HEIs in EU Member States and third countries associated to the Programme: **valid Erasmus Charter for Higher Education (ECHE)**

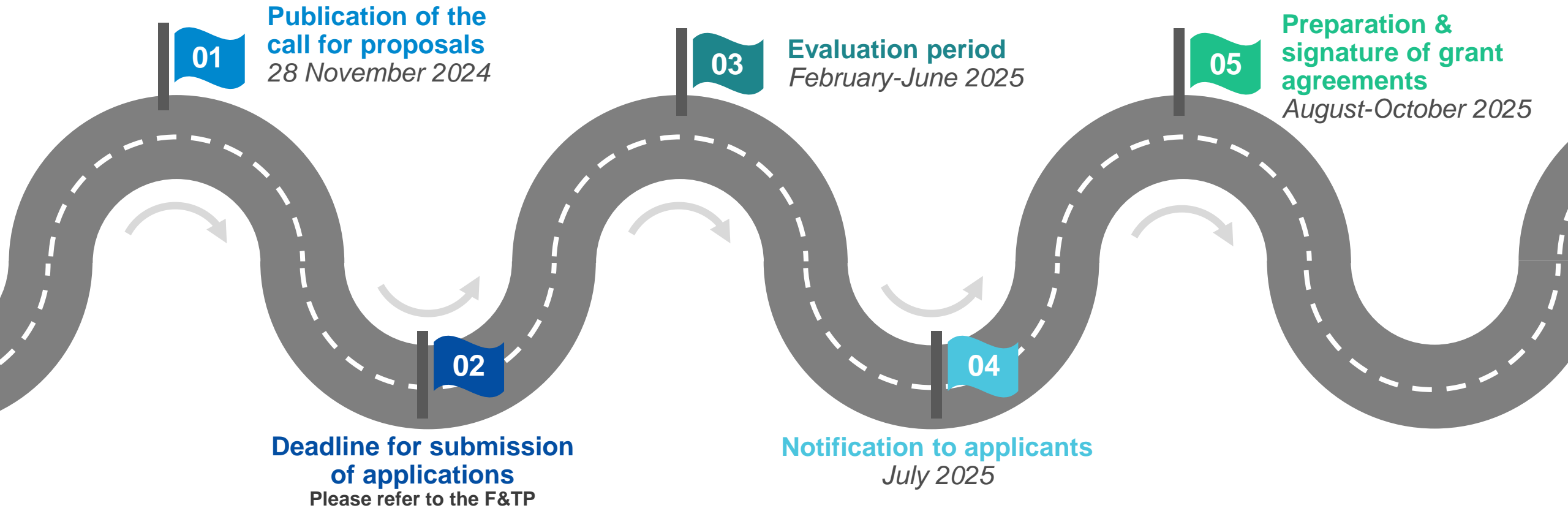
EMDM call for proposals 2025 at a glance

- ✓ Budget: ~ **3m €**
- ✓ Nr. of projects: ~ **50 projects**

Selection Roadmap



Main changes compared to call 2024

1

Applications can only be submitted by eligible HEIs established in an EU Member State or third country associated to the Programme. However, the project must include activities that involve higher education institutions from one or more countries not associated to the Erasmus+ programme.

2

The EMDM no longer focuses on 'under-represented' countries/institutions, but on innovative joint international masters.

3

Changes in the **evaluation procedure:**

- New weighting of award criteria (max. points) under 3 award criteria (except for 'Impact')
- New minimum thresholds for 3 award criteria (except for 'Impact')
- Slight rephrasing of award criteria, especially under 'Relevance'

EMDM Evaluation procedure



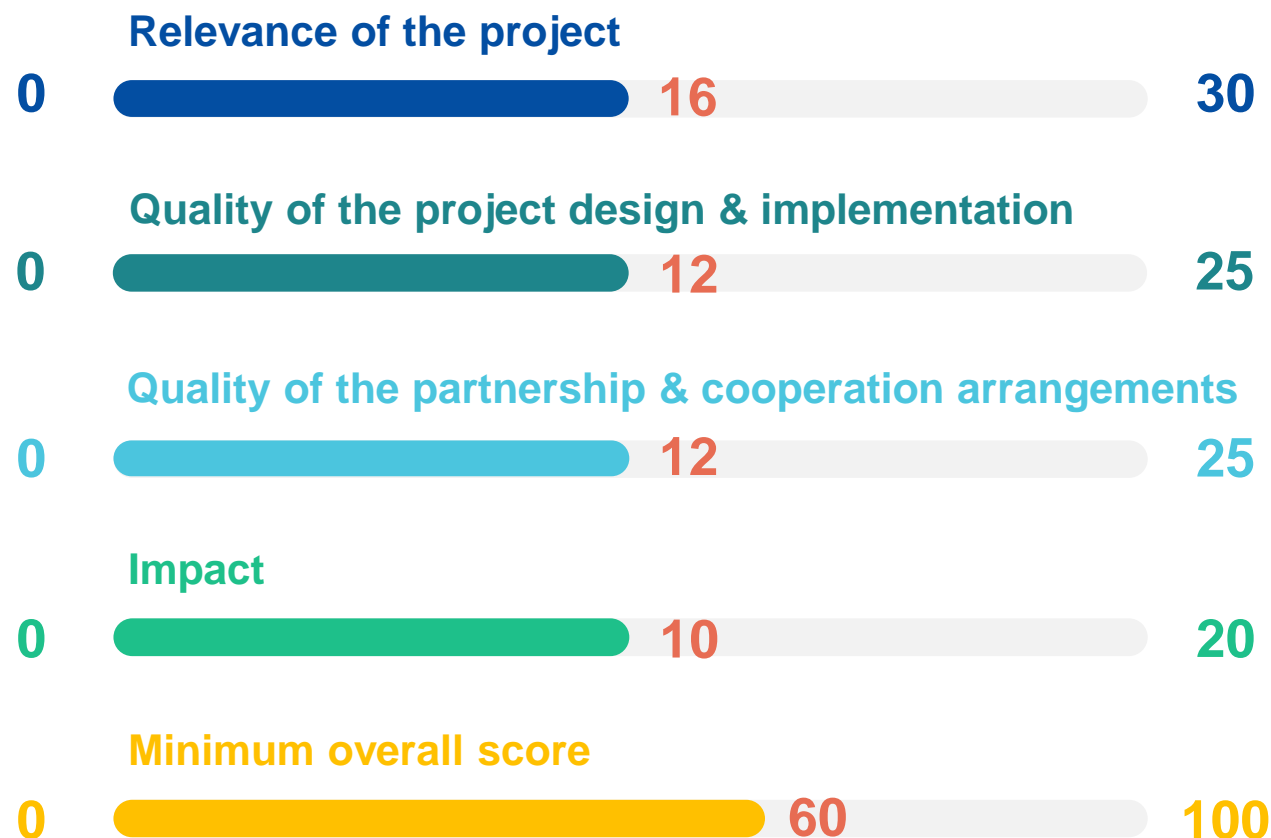
EVALUATION

Peer review by independent external experts – **2 experts** assess each proposal in a one-step evaluation procedure

In case of ex aequo, **priority** will be given to projects with highest scores for: “*Relevance of the project*”, then “*Quality of the project design and implementation*”, and then “*Impact*”

THRESHOLDS/Max POINTS

EMDM Award Criteria (1)

RELEVANCE OF THE PROJECT

(max 30 points – threshold **16 points**)

- ✓ The proposal is **relevant for the objectives of the Action**
- ✓ **Promotion of shared EU values** incl. respect for human dignity, freedom, democracy, equality, the rule of law and respect for human rights, as well as fighting any sort of discrimination
- ✓ The proposal is based on a **genuine and adequate needs analysis**
- ✓ The proposal is **innovative**, as compared to the offer of existing Master programmes

EMDM Award Criteria (2)

QUALITY OF THE PROJECT DESIGN & IMPLEMENTATION

(max 25 points – threshold **12 points**)



Concept and methodology: e.g. strategy to achieve the objectives and expected outcomes



Project management, quality assurance, monitoring and evaluation strategy: e.g. foreseen measures to ensure the project quality and timely implementation, planned steps to launch an accreditation/evaluation process



Project teams, staff and experts: e.g. foreseen operational resources, definition of roles and distribution of tasks in the project team

EMDM Award Criteria (3)

QUALITY OF THE PARTNERSHIP & COOPERATION ARRANGEMENT

(max 25 points – threshold **12 points**)



Consortium set-up: e.g. expected role of the participating organisations, rationale of their participation, added value and complementarity

IMPACT

(max 20 points – threshold **10 points**)



Impact and ambition of the EMDM project, including the appeal to students, professors and partner organisations **worldwide**.



Communication, dissemination and visibility: e.g. activities foreseen for the promotion and dissemination of the new Master programme and project outcomes



Sustainability and continuation: envisaged steps to successfully launch/implement the new Master programme and foreseen measures to ensure its sustainability

Application package

Complete **Part A & C (KPI)** directly on the Portal. Prepare **Part B** in advance and upload it together with the annexes



The application form is structured in three parts:



Part A – Administrative Forms

Contains general information about the project, data on the applicant organisation and contact persons



Part B – Technical description

Contains the narrative part of the project, the work package and deliverables



Part C – Administrative forms

Specificities about the EMDM (n° of ECTS, type of degrees to be awarded, participating organisations)
