Recent legal base

- Included by the Lisbon Treaty in 2009
- Article 165 TFUE

Priorities

- More active citizens
- Social inclusion through sport
- Improving good governance in sport
- Development of skills and qualifications in the field of sport

Treaty of Lisbon 2009
'The Union shall contribute to the promotion of European sporting issues, while taking account of the specific nature of sport, its structures based on voluntary activity and its social and educational function'
(Art.165)

Increasing financial budget

Erasmus+ sport actions

- 2014-2020 : 265 millions
- 2020 : 69,8 millions
- 2021-2027: 503 million euros

- *Building capacity to better fight doping in sport in Europe*
