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General Overview

The Project NET-IDEA aims at reinforcing the role of local authorities and their cooperation in the field of diversity promotion, interculturalism, antidiscrimination and inclusion of minorities. It is funded by the European Commission within the CERV-2021-CITIZENS-TOWN Call for Proposal and will last **24 MONTHS** from May 2022 to April 2024. NET-IDEA counts on the support of the Intercultural Cities Programme (ICC) **Programme) of the Council of Europe.**






