Additional budget to Erasmus + Programme

➤ Erasmus + 2022 budget for Sport:

- >70 M€ for sport overall
- 54 M€ for 2022 Call for proposals

➤ PPPAs 2022:

- 3.5 M€ for sport overall
- Call PPPA-SPORT-2022-GRASSROOTS-INNOVATION: 1.95 M€
- Call PPPA-SPORT-2022-PEOPLE-PLANET: 1.44 M€

Pilot Projects and Preparatory Actions

Definitions

- Pilot project

- A Pilot project is an initiative of an **experimental nature** designed to test the feasibility of an action and its usefulness. The duration of Pilot projects is limited to two consecutive years.

- Preparatory action

- A Preparatory action, normally the successor of a successful pilot project on the same matter, is designed to **prepare proposals** with a view to the adoption of future actions (like EU policies, legislation, programmes and the like). It may receive funding for three successive years.

Main characteristics

- Annual vote by the **European Parliament**
- Implementation by the **EACEA (starting in 2021, now the 2nd Call open)**
- Mono-beneficiary projects
- To prepare future EU actions in the field of sport
- To finance sport actions that are not funded through the Erasmus+ Sport Chapter



People and Planet - Background

Increasing **need for sustainability** and environmental change



Sport identified as **efficient tool** for creating a more sustainable Europe

This Pilot Project uses the power of sport to make European citizens aware of the importance of sustainability and to help them contribute to it

People and Planet - Objectives

- To **raise awareness, inspire behaviour, and lead the thinking** in European society on **how sport can enable and accelerate social and environmental transformation.**
- To **engage EU citizens** to actively participate in sustainable measures using the communicative power of sport, its major events and leading role models.

People and Planet – Expected Impacts

- Knowledge on new behavioural approaches needed to make the sport sector more environmentally sustainable;
- Sport organisations to become influential leaders in environmental transformation (development of approaches and toolkit);
- Sport to become a model of sustainability especially for European young generation;
- Socially and environmentally sustainable solutions for sport events.

Grassroots - Background

Sport and physical activities

- Traditionally in sport clubs with stable rules
- Large and costly sport facilities needed

Enlarging the offer

- More diverse, informal and open to new public



Evolution

- Rising mismatch between the supply of sport via traditional sport organisations and the demand of individuals

Attract new generation

- Sport clubs should improve their offer through creativity, innovation and new form of practices

Infrastructures

- Use and promote light and flexible ones allowing the practice of sport in a wider diversity of places


Grassroots - Objectives

- To give the opportunity to sport organisations to develop and promote **new forms of practicing sport** and physical activity through the adaptation of the infrastructure and/or the offer of sport activities/programmes
- To support the promotion of physical activity through **flexible, modern ways of practicing sport both in terms of offer** (trainings, activities) **and** in terms of **infrastructure**

Grassroots – Expected Impact

- Development of new forms of practices;
- Better integration of new ways of practicing sport and physical activity in the offer of the sport sector;
- Increased participation of young generations to sport;
- Development of light sport facilities, which directly complement the previous expected results.

Pilot projects and preparatory actions

- Pilot projects (PP) and Preparatory Actions (PA) are important tools for the formulation of political priorities
- They introduce new initiatives that might turn into standing EU activities and programmes (having their own budget lines)
- Sustainability and durability of the results produced by PPPAs are key elements for assessing the success of a pilot project or a preparatory action

EP resolution on EU sports policy: assessment and possible ways forward

- On 23 November 2021, Parliament adopted a resolution on the EU sport policy. In the report, the MEPs recommend:
 - 72. Stresses the need to **further increase funding for sport**, also beyond the Erasmus+ programme, in a targeted manner with a focus on the social dimension of sport, particularly in grassroots sports;
 - 73. Highlights **the importance of preparatory actions and pilot projects in the field of sport** which provide additional funding for grassroots sport and give promising results;
 - 74. Calls on the Commission to **increase the number of accepted pilot projects and preparatory actions** in the field of sport;

How we do it in the EP?

- MEPs present an idea/ proposal for a PP or PA
- For *new PPPA* proposals, it is highly recommended to look at past (adopted) PPPAs to avoid duplication of past efforts
- It is also possible to **seek informal advice from the competent Commission services at an early stage** and to test your ideas with them before submission in the pre-assessment
- The Commission **assesses the feasibility of these proposals** from a technical and legal point of view before Members and Committees take a final decision on whether or not to propose them

How does it work?

- Commission allocates to all submitted proposals a category ranging from A ('can be implemented as proposed') to D ('cannot be implemented or is already completely covered by existing initiatives')
- This informal **pre-assessment** or '**categorisation**' procedure helps to ensure that PPPAs that are ultimately adopted are workable and deliver tangible results
- **PPPA proposals must be submitted *twice*** in order to be adopted into the EU budget, once for an informal pre-assessment by the European Commission and then once again as budgetary amendments

8 June (tbc)	Adoption of Draft Budget by the Commission - Working Document IV on PPPAs shortly afterwards
End June (tbc)	Pre-assessment feedback on PPPAs from the Commission
2 July - at 10.00	Deadline for re-submitting PPPAs as budgetary amendments to the CULT secretariat (in English only) (cult-budget-2022@europarl.europa.eu)
12-13 July	Vote on budgetary amendments in CULT
2 September – at 12.00	Deadline for tabling budgetary amendments to BUDG/plenary (committees and MEPs)

PP Sport for People and Planet - a new approach on sustainability through sport in Europe

- necessary to accelerate our work towards achieving the Agenda 2030 and towards a smarter and greener Europe that is more connected, more social and more inclusive
- with its truly global reach, sport has the potential and the duty to contribute to all aspects of sustainability
- need a coordinated and action-oriented approach to harness the influence and resources of sport, bridging, connecting and blending social, environmental and digital transformations in Europe and beyond

PP 'Sport Supports' - emergency sport actions for youth

- main focus group are children and young people affected by humanitarian crises and mass migration processes in the context of war
- by improving their mental well-being by attending sport sessions, these individuals will eventually become ready to adjust to their new environment
- cooperation between grassroots sports clubs and centres that could offer social, psychological or pedagogical support would be important and required
- these programs should be implemented at the local level involving only one EU country, which is not possible under the current Erasmus+ Sport actions
