
Funding rules - differences between Lot 1 & Lot 2

Eligibility Criteria: Who can apply?

The applicants (beneficiaries and affiliated entities, if applicable) must be:

- Registered members of the Pact for Skills
- Public or private organisations legally established in an EU Member State or third country associated to the programme, such as: HE, VET, SMEs.... The list of possible organisations is included in the eligibility criteria, under "Eligible participating organisations - Who can apply?
- Organisations from third countries not associated to the Programme may also participate as beneficiaries, affiliated entities or associated partners, but not as coordinator, if their participation brings an essential added value to the project
- **Higher education institutions** established in an EU Member State or a third country associated to the Programme must hold a **valid Erasmus Charter for**
- 4 Higher Education (ECHE)

Criteria	Maximum points	Minimum pass points
Relevance of the project	25	13
Quality of the project design and implementation	30	16
Quality of the partnership and the cooperation arrangements	25	13
Impact	20	11

Total score: Maximum 100 points
To be considered for funding:

- 1. Minimum total score 70 points AND
 - 2. Minimum pass points

1) Relevance

 Relevance in terms of link to EU policy and initiatives – relevant for the chosen ecosystem

Purpose – relevant for emerging occupational profiles

- EU values
- Consistency
- Sector/area representation
- Digital skills, Green skills, Resilience skills & Deep tech skills
- Innovation
- European added value
- Education & training representation



(Relevance)

2) Quality of the project design and implementation

- Coherence: Consistency between activities and results
- Structure: Quality of the work programme (and its phasing)
- Methodology: use of the EU tools and skills when relevant
- Management
- Work Plan
- Quality of arrangements for the recognition and validation of qualifications
- Budget: Cost-effectiveness and allocation of appropriate resources – attention in case the proposal is an ecosystem in which a Blueprint is already ongoing
- Financial and Quality control: measures to ensure that the project implementation is of high quality





3) Quality of the partnership and the cooperation arrangements


- Configuration: the partnership is composed of partners of large-scale skills partnerships under the Pact for Skills
- Commitment: complementary contributions
- Involvement of third countries not associated to the Programme
- Tasks
- Collaboration/Team spirit
- Reward
