## Intra-Africa Academic Mobility Scheme 2022-2027

Overall objective: To increase skills and qualifications across the African continent



To promote **inclusive learning mobility** opportunities



To increase the **employability** of higher education students and trainees and their entrepreneurial skills







To reinforce focus on **climate change** mitigation and adaptation in higher education

To improve the **quality**, **relevance**, internationalisation of higher education in Africa





## Intra-Africa Academic Mobility Scheme 2022-2027

## Intra-Africa budget **2022-2024**: 60 million €

### **Mobility projects**

1st call for proposals NDICI-2023-MOBAF (4 April 2023) 27 mln € (≈ 15 projects)

2<sup>nd</sup> call for proposals end 2024/beg 2025 28 mln €  $(\approx 15-16 \text{ projects})$ 



Supporting measures

5 mln € 2023-2024 (implemented by EACEA)

• Consortia of Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) from Sub-Saharan Africa and the EU

## Purpose


- Organisation and implementation of international mobility to African HEIs for
  - Master & Doctorate students
  - Trainees
  - Staff members

## Thematic areas

 All thematic area but indicatively 40% of selected projects related to environment and climate change

## Grant per project and duration

- Maximum 1,8 mln € to fund institutional costs and scholarships
- 48 months (fixed duration)






## NDICI-2023-MOBAF Eligible consortium composition

Minimum 4 and maximum 6 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) from Sub-Saharan Africa

**One HEI** from one of the **EU Member States** (EU technical partner)

Only HEIs from Africa as lead applicant/coordinator

Other organisations from Africa can participate as **Associated Partners** 










## NDICI-2023-MOBAF **Eligible African regions and countries**

HEIs from Northern Africa region not eligible as beneficiaries under this call








# NDICI-2023-MOBAF **Eligible consortium composition:**

## NDICI-2023-MOBAF Eligible project activities

### **INSTITUTIONAL ACTIVITIES**

- Project management, cooperation,
- Capacity building
- Mobility promotion and selection
- Mobility implementation, services to students, recognition, monitoring
- Quality Assurance, dissemination, sustainability

#### SCHOLARSHIPS for INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY of:

Students (Master/PhD)

• Trainees (i.e. students enrolled in Bachelor, Master or PhD)

Staff members





## **Eligible scholarship holders**

### **STUDENTS** (at Master and Doctorate):

- any other African HEIs (TG2) (including from Northern Africa region)



#### **RAINEES**

**STAFF MEMBERS** employed in one of the HEIs members of the consortium, including the HEI from EU

# NDICI-2023-MOBAF



**national of and resident in** an African country *(including from Northern Africa region)* graduated/registered/admitted at one of the African HEIs member of the consortium (TG1) or

national of and resident in an African country (including from Northern Africa region) enrolled in a Bachelor/Master/PhD programme at African HEIs members of the consortium





## **Eligible mobility**

- Only HEIs from Africa involved in the project as applicants (beneficiaries) can host mobility of students and staff
- Mobility can only be toward an eligible African country different from the country of nationality and of residence of the scholarship holder
- Only organisations (public or private) established in the countries of the applicants (beneficiaries) HEIs from Africa can host trainees
- Student mobility:
  - credit-seeking mobility (leading to the academic recognition by the home HEI of the study/research period spent at the host HEI)
  - degree-seeking mobility (for a complete academic programme/leading to a degree)

## **Indicative mobility requirements/targets**

	➢ Min/max duration	Minimum Percentage
Master students	4 to 24 months	50%
Doctoral candidates	6 to 36 months	15%
Trainees	3 to 6 months	10%
Staff members	2 weeks to 3 months	10%

- Participation of women (25%)
- $\succ$  Scholarship holders with vulnerable status or special needs (10%)
- holders)
- Credit seeking mobility for students (25%)
