Pathways to School Success initiative (to be proposed in the first half of 2022)

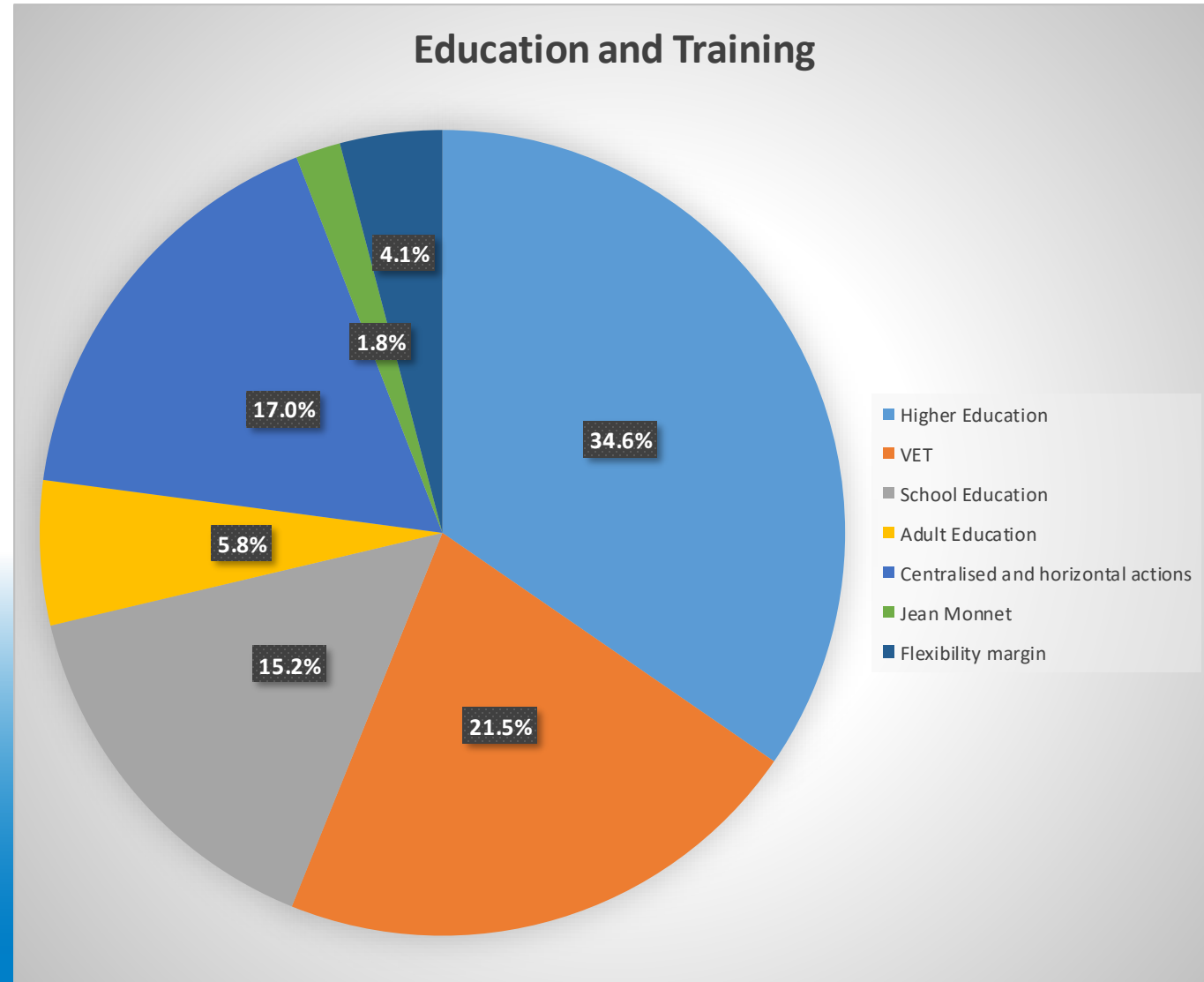


Erasmus+ Budget

Almost double compared to the previous programme for EU-27

Approx. EUR 26 billion

More than EUR 5,5 billion for Vocational Education and Training : mobility, cooperation projects.



Erasmus+ priorities – key ingredients for any project

✓ Inclusion and diversity

Erasmus+ is designed to be inclusive and to offer equal opportunities for everyone, no matter what their age, social or economic background. Dedicated additional funding is available for organisations that wish to make their projects more inclusive.



Digital education

The digital dimension runs through the whole programme. There are virtual learning activities, training courses for teachers who want to improve their use of digital tools, an online community and tools in eTwinning, and much more.

Environmental sustainability

Erasmus+ encourages all projects to incorporate eco-friendly practices and to educate their participants about environmental sustainability. For example, additional funding is available for using low-carbon transportation.
