Policy context

The double objective of the European Solidarity Corps

To provide young people, including people with fewer opportunities, the possibility to:

Make an
impactful and
durable
contribution to
local communities

Develop their skills and get some valuable experience in the process



Principles and objectives of humanitarian aid volunteering



Projects must be in line with the **principles** of **humanity**, **neutrality**, **impartiality**, **independence**, 'do no harm' principle.

Their objectives are **NOT** to deliver emergency response to disasters.

Most projects aim to contribute to **strengthening durably the capacity and resilience** of vulnerable or disaster-affected communities.

So they are rather about **long term development cooperation** than about crisis management.




The claims made in the proposals must be substantiated by convincing evidence

Projects must be needs-based and have an impact Volunteers must be at the centre of the design of projects.





Projects must be inclusive

What is the Quality Label for Humanitarian Aid Volunteering?



 A certification, precondition for participation in volunteering activities in support of humanitarian aid operations



 Compliance with the principles and objectives of the European Solidarity Corps



 Capacity of organisations to undertake quality volunteering activities in support of humanitarian aid operations



It does <u>NOT</u> automatically lead to funding



Types of Quality Label

Support role

- Support organisations are established in EU Member States or third countries associated to the programme (check Programme Guide 2024 p. 16 for more info).
- It entitles organisations to submit applications and coordinate or be part of partnerships.
- Tasks:
 - Supporting, preparing and/or training participants before departure;
 - Mediating between them and the host organisation;
 - Supporting participants upon return.

Host role

- Host organisations are established in third countries not associated to the programme (check <u>Regulation 2021/888, art. 10.2</u> for more info).
- It covers the full range of activities related to hosting a volunteer, including:
 - The development of a programme for the young person's activities;
 - Providing guidance and support to the participant during all the phases as appropriate.



How to obtain it?



SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

To take part in Humanitarian Aid Volunteering action under the 2024 call, organisations must apply for Quality Label in **September 2024**



ASSESSMENT

Applications will be assessed against eligibility, selection, exclusion and award criteria



AWARD

Valid for the entire duration of the programming period 2021-2027



Timeline

Submission deadline: September 2024 Evaluation phase: end of 2024 – beginning of 2025

Notification at the latest: 23/03/2025

Submission deadline of the next call 'Humanitarian Aid Volunteering': Spring 2025





Procedures to apply

1. Full procedure (FP)

New applicant organisations applying for the support or host role.


2. Simplified host procedure (SHO)

An organisation which applies for support role may also apply for host role on behalf of its branche offices located in third countries not associated to the programme.

The applicant support organiation is **accountable** for the quality and safety of the activities offered by the simplified hosting organisation(s).

Admissibility criteria

Via the Funding & Tenders Portal Electronic Submission System By the deadline: Funding & Tenders Portal Using the forms provided in the Submission System Readable, accessible and printable **Submission** Complete, including all documents and mandatory annexes Written in one of the EU official languages **Applications are limited to 40 pages**



Eligibility criteria

	Eligible Organisations	 Quality Label for support role State or a third country associated to the Programme. Quality Label for host role - any organisation legally established in a third country where humanitarian aid activities and operations take place and where there are no ongoing armed conflicts. Groups of young people are NOT eligible. An organisation that applies for support role may also apply for host role on behalf or its branches with which it shares the same legal personality (one legal entity = one Quality Label).
	Duration	 The whole duration of <u>the programming period 2021–2027</u>, subject to periodica reassessments by the EACEA.
	When to apply?	 Organisations willing to participate in Humanitarian Aid Volunteering projects under the 2025 call must apply for Quality Label via the <u>Funding & Tenders Portal</u>
	Where to apply?	 To the Education and Culture Executive Agency through the Funding and Tender Opportunities Portal of the European Commission.
19	Other Criteria	A declaration of honour signed by the legal representative.

Relevance

 Relevance of objectives to the priorities of the European Solidarity Corps and Humaintaria Aid Volunteering

Quality of measures

 Policies and measures compliant with the quality requirements of the European Solidarity Corps

Organisational capacity

 Capacity of the organisation in terms of structure, management and coordination with partners to engage in humanitarian aid activities



Relevance

Convincing motives for participation in the European Solidarity Corps

Organisation's objectives address relevant issues of the European Solidarity Corps

Organisation's activities and experience relevant for humanitarian aid and with a strong solidarity dimension

Commitment to the principles of humanity, neutrality, impartiality, independence and 'do no harm' principle

Proposal relevant for respect and promotion of shared EU values (freedom, equality, rule of law, respect for human dignity etc.)



Quality of measures

Activities respond to humanitarian aid needs and provide tangible benefits to local communities

Security, health, safety of volunteers are guaranteed

Measures to respect the avoidance of harmful activities principle

Adequate practical and logistical arrangements

Adequate mentoring support for volunteers

Adequate personal and psychological support for volunteers

Appropriate living and volunteering conditions

Measures to support specific needs of young volunteers with fewer opportunities

Avoiding job substitution and tasks with low learning impact

Promoting environmental sustainability and responsibility

Making use of digital tools and methods



Organisational capacity

Appropriate allocation of resources to manage the activities in accordance with quality standards (safety and security standards) Appropriate steps to ensure continuity of activities in case of organisational changes Good approach towards working with partners High quality measures for assuring the sustainability of the planned activities Quality project management (proper communication and coordination measures with other host/support organisations) High quality measures to disseminate the outcomes of the activities within and outside the participating organisations High quality measures for monitoring and evaluating the activities







To access existing draft proposals for this topic, please login to the Funding & Tenders Portal and select the My Proposals page of the My Area section.



Monitoring, Reporting and Quality Assurance



Changing/Updating the Quality Label

The organisations holding a Quality Label for Humanitarian Aid Volunteering must notify the awarding body of any changes in their organisation that should be reflected in their Quality Label.



Monitoring & Checks

The Quality Label will be periodically reassessed. The Executive Agency may carry out regular or ad hoc monitoring visits to verify that the organisations holding a Quality Label still meet the quality standards.



Termination

In cases of serious underperformance, failure to comply with Executive Agency's instructions and deadlines or repeated violations of the Programme rules, the Quality Label can be withdrawn. In addition, the awarding body may terminate a Quality Label if the organisation ceases to exist.
