

Eligibility Criteria



Be a legal entity (public /private)

- REFUGEES: org. mainly active in sport field and regularly organising sport competitions
- GRASSROTS: sport org. regularly organising sport competitions/ activities and with a European dimension
- DOPING: with international reach and investigative capabilities in the field of doping

Natural persons

are **NOT** eligible

with the exception of self-employed persons

Established in a EU Member State

NA for International Organisations and for Doping Call

Eligible activities (Grassroots)



Infrastructure upgrade and development of light sport facilities

Organisation of new forms of physical activities

Innovative approaches to training programmes

Eligible activities (Doping)



Development of a system for information sharing on legislation, best practice in investigation and for protection of whistle-blowers

Trainings to build investigative capacity of ADOs

Activities to support the creation of networks of investigators or source handlers

Studies, analyses, mapping projects, etc. to build capacity of the Anti-Doping Organizations and law enforcement agencies



Selection Criteria: Operational capacity



Applicants must demonstrate that they have :

- Technical know-how
- Qualifications
- Resources
- Project experience

Operational capacity check

- profiles of staff responsible for managing and implementing the project
- list of previous projects, including key projects for the last 4 years



Selection Criteria: Financial capacity



Demonstrate **stable and sufficient resources** to successfully implement the project and pay their share

Financial capacity check

- profit and loss account and balance sheet
- ➤ business plans
- ➤ audit report produced by an approved external auditor certifying the accounts for the last closed financial year



Award Criteria - Scoring

Relevance	40 p	40 p	40 p	20 p

Total	100 p	100 p	100 p	

Double threshold:

- 50% of each criterion
- at least 60 points in total

Doping	 supports Anti-Doping Organisations (ADOs) to collaborate with law enforcement agencies is based on relevant and concrete identification of needs has clearly defined and realistic objectives, addressing issues relevant to ADOs helps ADOs to develop protocols to ensure evidence gathering and information sharing between them and law enforcement allows for an international harmonised system covering all EU countries and, where relevant, non-EU ones

Impact	 Sustainability of the proposed activities Number of participants involved in and benefiting from the project's activities; Quality of measures aimed at sharing project outcomes towards external organisations and the general public.

Enter your email address in the field provided, then click the **Next** button. You will be prompted for your password.











